Native Reply boldly took the lead from between horses and drew clear nearing the far turn, then continued gamely in the drive to hold the advantage under a clever ride. D.Q.'s Image rallied from well out in the course in the drive and lasted over Doin OK for the place. Doin OK, unhurried while lacking early speed, began to advance on the far turn, raced into the stretch from between horses, then had to angle out several times for racing room out-wise moving well late from far out in the course. Arrow Sport moved up outside Pat The Tyrant on the backstretch, continued willingly but lacked the needed closing kick. Suzinmytan, along the inside in the stretch, pulled up in distress. Coelin At Ya was finished early. Pat The Tyrant set the pace for a half and gave way.

Texas Trio set the early pace on a short lead outside Que Me In, draw clear on the far turn, then held Never A Playboy safe under right-handed slapping and a strong hand ride after his rider dropped his whip leaving the furlong pole. Never A Playboy moved up outside Que Me In on the far turn, continued gamely in the drive but could gain little in the final furlong. Watchindance went willingly but never challenged the top pair. Gentleman Jove, a bit slow to gain stride at the start, lodged his best bid three wide on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. Que Me In, on the early pace along the inside, saved ground to the stretch and tied.

Alysheba, came in a bit at the start to brush Candi's Gold, was reserved early while saving ground, was angled out once on the backstretch, made a run three wide on the second turn, caught Candi's Gold approaching the sixteenth marker and proved best under pressure. Candi's Gold brushed at the start, prompted the early pace inside, was allowed to drop back before a half, was sent up inside the leaders entering the second turn to gain a short lead, came off the inside when in command entering the stretch, drifted out a bit in upper stretch then held on tenaciously in a game effort. Parochial vied for the early lead between rivals, remained off the inside after gaining command before a half, continued well when challenged by Candi's Gold entering the second turn, was angled towards the inside in midstretch after Candi's Gold drifted a bit then weakened late. Temperate Sit, taken back after an alert beginning, moved closer inside entering the backstretch, came out to move to a challenging position after five furlongs, moved back to the inside on the second turn but weakened inside in the drive. Fortunate Moment prompted the pace for six furlongs and faded. Monesturrari close up for a half, faded. Parditoe's Son was through early. Wayne's Crane steadied and was angled towards the inside after a half then trailed.

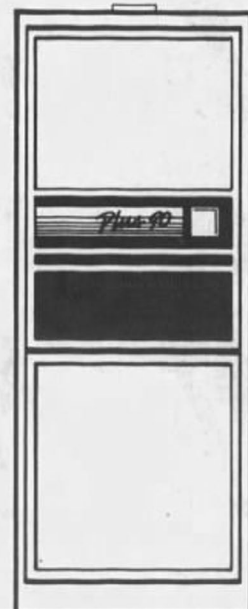
