On The Line, rated on the early pace, drew clear on the backstretch, rallied gamely after losing the lead in the upper stretch but cold not come back on. Arctic Dream, sit wide into the clubhouse turn, was forwardly placed for a bit placed a half pole for a half, continued with the lead outside the clubhouse turn and was outrun thereafter. Captain Skiff was pinched back from between horses entering the clubhouse turn. On Retainer, prompted the early pace outside the winner but gave way after five furlongs. War Debt was five wide into the clubhouse turn.

Arrow Sport moved up outside Pat The Tyrant on the backstretch, continued willingly but lacked the needed closing kick. Buximyuz, along the inside in the stretch, pulled up in distress. Comin At Ya was finished early. Pat The Tyrant set the pace for a half and gave way.


