**PICK: 7 RUIVA**

Wesley Ward is a master with two year olds. He is 29 for 69 (42%) at 4.5-5F with a debut 2YO on the dirt in a MSW. While most of those wins came at KEE, he is 3 for 10 with such here at CD. 3<sup>rd</sup> dam is Quite Dance. She is the dam of \$4.4M earner Saint Liam and 400k earner Quiet Giant. That filly is the dam of \$16M earner Gun Runner. She certainly has the bloodlines.

**VALUE: 11 TRACTION PARK**

The average 2YO debut winning percentage for sires is about 11%. This sire, Vekoma, has had 23% of his offspring win in the debut. Trainer Mark Casse has a decent record with first time starting 2YO's. The female family produced a superstar in Silverbulletday. She won \$3M in her career. She took the 1998 BC Juv Fillies and the 1999 Kentucky Oaks for Bob Baffert.

Thought he was too close to a fast pace last time out. It was also from a wide post draw so you'd think they'd allow him to sit back off the pace somewhat here. Bred well for the turf. Second dam is Take the Ribbon who was twice G1 turf placed in her career. Trained gets about 20% going MSW to md cfm in spots like this. Will see a better result from him in this one.

**VALUE: 4 TURBO LAUNCH**

Named in honor of a Minnesota horse from 1987 who beat G1 winner Lost Kitty in the Canterbury Debutante. The owners are from Minnesota. Joe Sharp is 8 for 22 (36%) with 14 in the money (64%) second off a layoff of this type and Jose Ortiz in the irons. Breeding leans a bit shorter so that could be an issue. Worked well since the last start. Drop here makes sense.

This race feels like one that could be won by a deep closer as this one is. She finished 5<sup>th</sup> beaten less than 7 in MSW in her second start which came at KEE last year. Blinkers on in the next two but removed in the last start. That was a decent run when 4<sup>th</sup> beating 8 foes there at Indiana. Trainer 5 for 22 and 12 in the money first off a layoff of this type. Gaffalione is up.

**VALUE: 7 RED RAINBOW**

Connections looking for the right spot for this one and this is likely it. She split the field setting a fast pace at KEE in the second start in MSW company at boxcar odds. Good 4<sup>th</sup> next beating 5 runners when, again, going too fast early. Came in late for third in last at 17-1. Should get some pace to set up a move. Trainer, rider, owner won at KEE at 45-1 two weeks ago.

Nice win in the debut which is nothing new for a Wesley Ward first time 2YO at KEE in those 4.5F hook races. She was 1-5 off odds and ran like that was an overlay. She was really eased up late in the race. She could have won by much more. Wesley Ward won this race last year with a second timer who easily won in debut. 200k purchase. Rosario had his choice of 2 here.

**VALUE: 5 SUPER SAIYAJIN**

Nice effort in the MSW race in his second start. He went to the front and opened up before he was tagged late by the winner. None of the horses from that race have run back and they all were firsters except this one. Tough race to analyze. The first start came on a sloppy track and he ran very well when only 3 back. He was off slow in there. A player in a very small field.

Huge rally to win here two back when she had a tough inner draw. Was just starting to gather and move last time out but Ortiz might have started her a little late. Hasn't run for near 11 months but the works coming back are amazing. Was on a tight hold outworking allowance stablemate Furio in the 4/5 move. Last drill was 3/5 faster than anyone else that day.

**VALUE: 5 JUSTINQUESO**

She was the favorite in her last start which was her first off a layoff. She beat only 3 home in a flat effort but it was on a synthetic track and first start of the year. Last time she was here at CD was two back when she closed strongly to get up for second at 14-1. Will need some pace to develop as she is a stone cold closer. There are enough in here who will set it up.

Miserable trip last out. He hit the gate from the break. Then steadied sharply entering the turn and gave way. Crushed here two back for 50k with this same rider (Gaffalione) up. Toss the sloppy track 3 back at KEE. In over his head 4 back. Sneaky good work on April 9<sup>th</sup>. Last 4 starts for this trainer off layoffs at CD on dirt produced 2 wins and 2 show finishes.

**VALUE: 5 GORDON'S LEGACY**

Thought both starts were very good. He won in the debut back in Feb at Santa Anita. That was down-the-hill from the rail on the turf. It's very tough to win from the inside at that distance there. Was game in defeat in the small field last out. Has a sib who was a G3 winner on the dirt so the move to that surface might be ok. Trainer 4 for his last 7 taking over for this owner.

**PICK: 2 PARCHMENT PARTY**

There is inordinate amount of early speed in this marathon and it sets up perfectly for this late runner. He won 3 of his last 4 starts with the only loss in the \$6M Melbourne Cup two back in Australia. He's not a turf horse so that race is a toss. He has two wins in five starts here at CD. 5<sup>th</sup> beaten 10 in last came back to run 3<sup>rd</sup> by one length vs. opt clm 30k next at OP.

**VALUE: 5 INTERCEPTOR**

If this race turns into a riders race this might be the one you want. Flavian Prat gets up for this one who has two wins and four in the money from the four starts since the claim. Note he was a long way clear of third in the 150k stakes last time out at AQU. He's been on or near the lead lately but his style is more just in behind. Could end up with the run of the race.

**PICK: 12 HEART SPIN**

It really depends on how the turf track is playing. This one is going to come from the parking lot in the stretch. He have a lot of kick in the lane but will he start moving soon enough to win. Good run on this track two back when beaten just 3 at 32-1. His lone win came here on this turf at this distance. Winner two back won a 100k stakes next out at Fair Grounds.

**VALUE: 4 OAK ALLEY**

Very turf pedigree as the sire Kitten's Joy is almost always a turf influence. Has been on grass 5 times and has a win (at Ellis Park) and a third place finish in a MSW at KEE. Forced into early action at 56-1 in the last start vs. better at TP. She prefers a bit more rate to her and should get that here. The early position decides this race for most of the runners today.
