FLOWER ALLEY came away well and took a position to the outside of pacesetter BELLAMY ROAD, stalked that rival for the opening three quarters, was sent after the leader in earnest approaching the stretch, responded to steady left handed pressure and drew clear in the final furlong. BELLAMY ROAD was sent directly to the front, set the pace along the inside, responded when confronted by the winner turning for home, dug in bravely on the rail in the stretch but could not stay with FLOWER ALLEY in the final furlong. ROMAN RULER was taken in hand after the start, was rated along while three wide, advanced three wide on the second turn but had no response when put to the test in upper stretch. DON'T GET MAD was unhurried while outrun along the inside early, put in a good run on the second turn, came wide into the stretch but had little left and faded in the drive. ANDROMEDA'S HERO raced close up along the rail and had no response when roused entering the second turn. REVERBERATE was outrun early, raced three wide and tired after the opening three quarters. CHEKHOV was outrun after a sluggish start, raced inside and had no response when roused.
