CANONERO II, void of speed and unhurried for three-quarters, was forced to come out to launch his bid leaving backstretch, continued to circle his field entering stretch to take command with a bold rush and was under intermittent urging to prevail. JIM FRENCH, allowed to settle in stride, moved up along inside on second turn, was forced to come out between horses for drive and finished with good courage. BOLD REASON, badly outrun for six furlongs, slipped through along inside thereafter but could not gain through closing drive. EASTERN FLEET, away alertly to gain a forward position along inside, was caught in slightly close quarters on leaving backstretch, moved willingly when clear to gain command between calls in upper stretch but had little left when real test came. UNCON-SCIOUS, never far back, moved up boidly on final bend but could not sustain his bid. BOLD AND ABLE, sent to fore at once, saved ground much of way and succumbed readily at top of stretch. LIST found his best stride too late. TWIST THE AXE faltered after moving into contention on final bend. IMPETUOSITY could not menace. BARBIZON STREAK dropped back after encountering close quarters leaving backstretch. KNIGHT COUNTER stopped suddenly.
