PICK: 3 QUICK TO ACCUSE
Was able to finish second in a 200k stakes at 1 mile in just his third start. Connections tried him in the G3 Remsen after but might not have cared for the off-track. Last time he went 7F was three back and he was rolling late to get into a win photo at nearly 15-1. Be the Boss was 4th and won an allw next out.

VALUE: 6 KAZ SUGAR BANK
Last win came for 16k at Penn National with Torres aboard at 5-1. Was 22-1 two back but nearly caught Fortunes Nephew for third. Made up a lot of ground again in the last start when he went from 7th at the midway point to third picking up 7 lengths. Could use some pace to close into. Looks like a contender.

PICK: 5 STAMP OF APPROVAL
Since 2020, Chad Brown has started 19 times with a debut dirt sprinter in MSW at AQU for 3YO+ with this rider. He won 9x (47%) and in the top two 16x (81%). Sire gets 14% firsters. Chad Brown has had some success with Nyquist offspring. Brown is 37% for this owner in similar debut scenarios here in NY.

VALUE: 6 MUSIC MELODY
Brad Cox won with his last two first timers for this owner. One was in mdn clm 30k at CD on the dirt in a sprint. The other was in MSW at SAR in a turf route at 15-1. Best runner in the female family is the 2013 G1 Arkansas Derby winner Overanalyze. She went for just 80k at KEE Sep 22 sale. Some things to like.

Both halves of this Linda Rice entry (assuming she doesn't scratch one) can win here. Rice reclaimed this one (and has claimed him twice). Has won and run second twice in the three starts for Rice. Other half of the entry will likely be the closer. This one is going to the front. Not facing anything of note here.

VALUE: 4 FLASHY ALEX
Low percentage trainer pops every so often at big odds. This one broke his maiden from off the pace at 19-1. Willing to excuse last on the muddy track. He was acting up, broke slow and was wide from a wide post. When this trainer is ready to strike, his runners take money early in the betting. Look for it.

Her last three starts are all good enough to win. 7th from the start two back returned to win a 40k claimer by 9 with a 77 Beyer. Cox 41% when 2-1 or less at over 1M on dirt.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 SWEET MYSTERY 5YO mare has been a check getter. No disgrace in 3rd beaten just under 9 lengths two back (about 3 behind the top choice) when she pressed a quick early pace. The one she dueled with finished last beaten about 32 lengths. The winner won again in a similar spot and then finished 3rd in a 150k stakes. Debut came against winners at a route on the turf. That winner has since won the Dania Beach at GP (and was 3rd in the G3 Kittens Joy there after). Last race was on a muddy track from the 10 post and got a wide trip. Trainer won 2 of his last 4.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 AVA'S UNCLE BILLY There is a lot of guessing in this one. It feels like a race where you should be forgiving and really treat many of these as 1st timers. This one was bet down to under 4-1 in the debut but could've bled as Lasix was added next out. Both starts on off tracks. Sire Uncle Mo gets 150k as a stud fee. Should be better. He's 4 for 5 for this owner with a debut mdn clm 50k sprinting on dirt for Cal-breds (winners odds were 10-1, 7-2, 5-2, 5-2). Dusted stablemate Dangerous Game (who is in this race) in the recent work. Alsagoor was up in the drill.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 DISOBEY Trainer did not win a race last year. But he finished in the money with 8 of his 13 starters. Winner of the last start was a neck away from winning 3 straight stakes after that win. Obviously the layoff along w/ the low percentage outfit is a major concern. He's worked consistent since Halloween. Check betting. A) 6,7 B) 2,5,8 C) 1,3,4</p>
<p>7 – GOLDEN GATE R7 (5:45 ET) 58 CLM 6K, 1M SYNTHETIC</p> <p>9 GALLANT WARREN 10-1 8 SUGAR BEETS 9-2 1 AZURE STAR 5-2 5 TWIRLING DERBY 12-1</p> <p>PICK: 9 GALLANT WARREN Very evenly matched field. A lot will depend on who gets the best trip. There are 2 need-the-lead types in the race. This one should be one of the closers. He came from last to get into second last time out at this level. 12 of 23 in the money at the distance. Doesn't win out of turn but is a fit with this group.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 SUGAR BEETS Another who will want the pace to be contested in the early stages. He is a deep closer. He's been in 6 straight mile races on this synthetic. All were for a tag of 10k to 16k. This is the lowest level he's been at for over 13 months. 6-time winner at 1M. Comes in off a poor race. Will look to regain his prior form. A) 1,8,9 B) 2,5,7 C) 3,4,6</p>	<p>8 – SANTA ANITA R9 (6:00 ET) 73 OPT CLM 40K, 1M TURF</p> <p>10 COMRADERY 6-1 2 CALI BAY 3-1 3 GIOVINAZZO 5-1 11 DON'T SWEAR DAVE 6-1</p> <p>PICK: 10 COMRADERY If you look past the 3-race stretch before he moved to Hector Palma, he was very consistent with high 80's Beyers on the turf. Comes into the race off of two career best speed figures and those were the first two under Palma. Loves the distance and he'll get the run of the race sitting 4th behind the speed.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 GIOVINAZZO Ran a winning race in 3 of the last 4 starts. He has exceptional speed but might be in for an early fight with other speed in the race. If he gets loose from that speed he'll prove tough to reel in. Eurton has had a slow start to 2024 but had a big year in 2023. Fresu was up for 2 of the 3 wins. Pace will decide it. A) 10 B) 2,3,7,11 C) 4,5,6,8,9</p>	<p>9 – GOLDEN GATE R8 (6:15 ET) 32 MDN CLM 12K, 5.5F SYNTHETIC</p> <p>2 I AM AMADEO 8-1 4 REEF CITY 3-1 1 ATTA BOY LLYOD 2-1 3 SARK 4-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 I AM AMADEO Going to overlook the route try last out since this is just a 5.5F sprint. Drew the rail in his first 3 starts, all at 5.5F. The third last time at 12k claiming was a good run in this context. Notice he was 4th two back in a 25k claimer. Two other major players entered here were behind him in that race. Looks an overlay.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 REEF CITY It's never easy to drop in from route races to a 5.5F sprint and sprinting for the first time in a long time as this one did last out. He did little until very late. Should be a bit sharper in the early going here. He faced better company in So Cal in all other races in his career. Finally draws a good post. Big late move.
