

ON THIS DATE (1988) – PRINCESS ELAINE was a Canterbury Downs legend who won 8 of 15 starts at the Shakopee track and is in the CBY Hall of Fame. On July 16, 1988, Princess Elaine circled the field and crushed 11 foes in the Minnesota Breeders' Oaks as the 2-1 second choice. She was voted the '88 3YO Filly Champ and '89 Older Filly/Mare Champ.
