Really sharp work on the Belmont training track on 3/30.</p> <p>Value: 5 Fingal's Cave Lightly raced 5YO mare has had just one start in the last year and a half. It was an easy win in the Bay Ridge. Donk is 5 for 23 (21%) off a layoff of this type on dirt. 3 of the 5 wins were at AQU (1 by this mare). He won the debut at MTH back in June and that race has turned out to be strong. Opened up in last before getting caught by a Chad Brown colt who hasn't run back yet. He'll move forward off that race. He has a blistering bullet drill since.</p> <p>Value: 1 Cascais Have to think this one hated the muddy track he got last two times out. He basically eased in both. Ran well in all 3 other starts and won the only time on a fast track. Has a perfectly spaced worktab for Chad Brown. Sib to stakes winner Mundaye Call (sprinting on dirt). Notice it was nearly 18 back to third in the race 2 back. Good form.</p> <p>Value: 2 Whocouldaskformo Stretched out and won for fun in her second start. Had a troubled trip in the Suncoast two back. That race turned out to be tough. The winner took the G2 GP Oaks at 11-1 in her next start (92 Beyer). 4th won an opt clm at TAM in her next start. It was basically a match race and this one always looked a winner there. Nash won the 200k Hot Springs at OP next at even money by over 5. Is a sib to the 1.3M earner (all turf sprints) Private Creed.</p> <p>Value: 1 Resilience Dam half to G1 winning turfers Courageous Cat and After Market. 2nd dam won two G1's and \$1.6M. Very good 4th in the Risen Star, a loaded G2 at FG. Show finisher came back to win the La Derby. Seems to be improving in each start. Serious work pattern for this. He hit the board just 21 times on that angle (24%) in the last 5 years. However, he's 6 for 17 (35%) with 11 in the money (65%) with a 2nd timer who hit the board in debut. Encouraged to Rosario stay. Nice 4F Belmont drills.</p> <p>Value: 3 Granadilla Was bet in the debut (although that could have been due to Irad Ortiz aboard). She showed a bit of speed but tired late. Show finisher won a MSW next (63 Beyer) and then was second in a 100k stakes at 9-1.
