

ON THIS DATE (1987) – BLAIR'S COVE won the prestigious Bashford Manor at Churchill Downs in 1987 as a first timer and put Mn-breds on the map. On July 14, 1987, he made his 2nd start (1st at Canterbury) in the Minnesota Breeders'. He was upset by Performing Artist as a 1-9 favorite after he broke poorly. Blair's Cove would go on to win \$533,528 in his career.
