

ON THIS DATE (1985) – CACHUMA was a popular horse in early days at Canterbury Downs. He was claimed for 50K in California by a partnership that involved Mike Lynn and Ralph Strangis. On July 6, 1985, Cachuma won the first MN-bred/owned race, the 20,000 Minnesota Breeders. He won 8 times at Canterbury in a career that spanned 8 years.

This is a big closer and the pace appears to be a fast and contested one with a few stretching out. Runs right by. VALUE: 1 LOGAN'S LEOPARD Just a field of four and this one is likely to be sent from the rail to hold position with a good gate rider up. Will sit just in behind the speed as he did for two wins at TUP in Feb. Expecting better in here. Ark-bred had a couple of good efforts at OP this spring. VALUE: 3 MADISON'S QUARTERS Trainer Joel Berndt has two here. This is the one who will likely sit just behind a fast pace similar to how she ran 3 back in a win vs similar. Eikleberry won 25% of his starts for Berndt here last 2 years. She was on the board 6 of 7 last year in MSW. Problem is the most recent run was an awful last and Arietta bails for the rail filly. Wins with prior form. A) 1,2,3 B) 7 C) 4

VALUE: 7 UNDECIDEDCERTAINTY She had just one start and it came back in early May at nearly 100-1 in a strong MSW at OP. The winner was an Asmussen firster well bet. 5 th beaten 12 won a MSW at CD last week. Has a solid rider aboard. Has a \$1.6M turf winner in the female line (won 3 G1's on grass). Excuses in the last two (wet, bad stumble). Trainer is on fire right now. VALUE: 2 HISSY MISSY She lost all chance in the 106K Rainbow last time out when she broke in the air at 51-1. Relegated to off-tracks in every other start. Sib to Jomelo who won 270k on the grass. Surprises in first turf start. VALUE: 7 CLASSY INDIVIDUAL Really unlucky to lose the last start as he just got outnodded by the winner. He ran well here in Mn-bred company and he is 5 for 10 in the exacta at this track. High level connections are starting to heat up.
