Momsfurrari took the early lead inside horses, was smoothly rated on the lead for the slowly run opening six furiongs, drew clear on the far turn, gamely responded when challenged entering the stretch, drifted outward under right-handed urging in midstretch causing Joel to check, then drew clear again late. Boishol Boy, unhurried early, mounted his rally four wide on the stretch turn, rallied outside horses in the drive but was outfinished by the winner. Joel stalked Momsfurrari during the early going, lodged his bid outside that rival nearing the stretch, was between horses when forced to check in midstretch, then continued with good courage. The stewards lit the inquiry sign following the finish, then jockey Kutz aboard Joel lodged an objection against Momsfurrari and Bolshol Boy for interference in the stretch. After reviewing the incident the stewards

disqualified Momsfurrari to third. Forkintheroad saved ground to the stretch, got closest to the leaders nearing the furlong pole, then flattened out slightly late. Honor Medal rallied into the stretch while well removed from the inner rail but lacked the needed closing response. Dear Rick, forwardly placed outside horses early, dropped from contention in the final quarter. Tourismo was finished early. Blue Buckaroo was never a factor.
