His 2 worst starts were from posts 8 and 11, so no surprise that trainer Nick Zito went inside for the Preakness after pressing a wicked pace from post 11 in the Ky. Derby; Bailey's looking for Preakness win number 3 (Hansel, '91, Red Bullet, 2000) and Zito's Preakness winner Louis Quatorze won this race after finishing 16th, beaten 23 lengths in the Derby; figures to be a major presence from the start, but may not be able to avoid being caught up in another swift pace.

Derby runners have won 20 of the last 21 Preakness Stakes; mixed feelings.
