The winner was a Chad Brown who came back to run well (4th of 11) in the G3 Florida Oaks. Dutrow goes back to Dylan Davis. He was up in the stakes photo finish. 2nd time Lasix. Expect more.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 DROP THE HAMMER In the last 28 days, trainer Graham Motion has started 9 horses beyond 1M. He won with 6 of them (67%) and 8 of the 9 ran in the top two. That includes a G3 win here, a G3 win at GP and the Virginia Oaks at Colonial. 2 of the wins came at this distance (1M 1/2). Purchased privately after the turf win at GP. Major traffic two back. The drop to 50k first off that purchase is sensible. She's run well enough vs. straight maidens that the drop in class puts her at the head of these. Now with higher percentage trainer David Jacobson. Picks up one of the top riders, Irad Ortiz. Will be finishing from the back.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 MINK STOLE Claimed for 50k out of the start 5 back. She's nibbled in straight MSW at TP since then. She really outran her odds for the new connections, and that included a runner-up at 13-1 first off the purchase. She's only run on fast dirt one time since the debut and that produced a runner-up at CD when off at 5-1 in 30k claiming. Reared at the start 2 back but still ran well enough. 3rd from there won twice in the starts since before 11th in the BC Juv Fillies for Aidan O'Brien. Was clearly best at FG last out in a productive race.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 ABIENTOT 1st, 3rd and 6th place finishers from the \$1M Untapable at KD are in this race. This one was third beaten just over a length at 16-1. She came back to beat 11 foes in the G3 Matron at Aqueduct. Had the 10 post out of 14 runners in the G1 BC Juvenile Turf and stopped in her first try going long. Excellent works. She was second in the debut at SAR to a filly that won run 2nd in a G1 here in the start after and then ran 3rd in the G1 BC Juvenile Fillies. Show finisher in there crushed in the G1 Frizette next and was 4th in that BC Juv Fillies. Big changes with the cutback, addition of Lasix and removal of blinkers. Workouts are strong for this.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 GIRLS ROCK Think she was unlucky to press the pace into a :21.2 and have to duel with two really promising fillies. The winner, who went wire to wire for Cherie DeVaux, came back and ran 2nd in the G2 FG Oaks in her 2nd start. Second beat a MSW race here 4 days ago when off at 1-2 odds. Cuts back to a mile for just his second time. The other was a third in this race last year. He was also coming out of the Grade 1 Pegasus. The 2025 version he exits was a key race. 5th, 6th, 8th, 9th and 12th from that race all came back to run 1st or 2nd in stakes (Beyers of 94 to 97 for them). Sharp drills.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 TRIKARI He had some run as the 5-2 favorite in the G3 last out but was stopped in midstretch and lost momentum. Faced a strong group of older runners at Santa Anita 2 back. The winner was 2nd by less than a length next out in the Grade 1 BC Mile on the turf. Was tremendous facing 3YO's much of 2024. Love this turf worktab. He'll get that chance today. The pedigree leans dirt. The best runners for the sire are dirt types like Olympiad (G1 Jockey Club Gold Cup) and Charlatan (G1 Ark Derby). So it is possible he steps up on the surface change. Doesn't have to improve much off of back to back 2nd place finishes.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 ABUNDANCE 5 of the last 7 times Todd Pletcher went MSW to maiden claiming he was either 1st or 2nd (2 wins). This one hasn't shown much in 3 starts. Pletcher trying to figure out what he wants (all 3 surfaces in the 3 starts). Faced one of the Ky Derby favorites, Tappan Street, in that GP debut. 8th by 18 from there won back in MSW at GP.
