 Was in the 7 post right next to the top choice 2 back and he was even wider on the first turn. He stayed wide the entire race and lost a lot of ground. Nice surge late to get into the photo. Flopped a bit first off the claim last out. That was in for 25k and he is dropping back to the right level. He will be in the mix.

 She probably needed a bit of a break after facing a lot of top level fillies and mares over 10 starts in '23 for Carla Gaines. She won right off the bench in Aug and that running style, in that win, pressing early, might be the preferred style in this spot. Just short of \$1M in earnings. She is a very classy turf runner.

VALUE: 1 MOUFFY
 Shipper from Kentucky has run pretty well in last 4 starts. Was a beaten favorite in the last two but is now moving back to the grass where she has won 2 of 2 starts. Wouldn't be surprised if the rider sends here from the rail. This is a paceless race. 2nd dam won the 2008 BC F&M Turf (and \$3M) for this owner.

<p>5 – SANTA ANITA (5:15 ET) 85 ROBERT LEWIS (G3) 200K, 1M DIRT</p> <p>6 NYSOS 4-5 8 MC VAY 20-1 7 STRONGHOLD 6-1 5 COACH PRIME 5-1</p> <p>PICK: 6 NYSOS Absolutely crushed in both starts and certainly has the look like another Bob Baffert superstar. Female line produced the 2001 Breeders' Cup Distaff winner Unbridled Elaine. Baffert has won this race 5 years in a row and 11 times overall. Working like he is set to fire once again. Clearly one to beat but at low odds.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 MC VAY Has the look of a colt who was prepping for this all the way. Steadied in a tough trip from the rail in the debut which was nothing more than giving him one run around the track. Closed smartly behind a very well meant Baffert firster last out. Connections put up \$1.25M for him. The dam won a Grade 1 going 1M 1/4 for Mandella on her way to 900k won on the grass. Mandella wanted the turf in the debut but it was scratched off and she won a match race on the dirt. Troubled trip in the SA Oaks. Mandella 7 for 17 (41%) at the meet. Had a strong, steady worktab.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 MISS LIZZY She's only been off the turf twice for O'Neill. Both of those were affected by major traffic issues. She's been in the exacta in 4 of 6 on the turf here at Santa Anita. O'Neill is having a pretty decent meet with 10 wins already. Fresu was aboard 3 times on this one and in the exacta twice. Goes back to Rispoli who had a win and two runner-up finishes in his 3 starts on him prior to last. Can get out and press the pace or sit back and make a bit of a run in the lane. Slight lean in an evenly matched event.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 TAHOE SECRETS It seems the pace could be on the faster side in this one. If this rider can get this one to settle just off the pace, he might have a chance to win. Added the blinkers back last out and it had a negative effect. Connections stick with the blinkers. He finally won after 7 losses in a row to start his career. He followed that up with another win. Was hindered by the very slow early pace in last. The winner was right on that pace and kicked back in the end. There will be a quicker pace in this one. Seems his best at the 1M distance.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 AH JEEZ He was right behind the top choice in the last two starts. O'Neill puts the blinkers on hoping to focus his attention. New rider Berrios gets up and he has been excellent on the turf in Southern California in the last few years. Seems to be arching in the right direction of late. She has been Grade 1 place sprinting (on this dirt back in 2022 when 3rd in the La Brea). Had never been out of the money sprinting before her last start when a decent 5th in the G1 BC F&M Sprint. Working strongly for this. Pace flow is in her favor. Looks ready here.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 CHIMOSA She's 4 for 9 on fast dirt but 0 for 4 on anything else so far in her career. Sharp win at 8-1 two back when she closed in to win going away. That was after the rider change to Frey (who is at OP riding Wynstock in the Southwest for Bob Baffert). Goes to Periera. He was bet in each of those races so someone felt there was more with this one. Clean trip in the maiden win 3 back. Really bottled up in early/mid stretch two back. Fits here if he can just stay out of his own way. Will be a price.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 LIVING LIFE Could be a fast pace and this one might be closing from the farthest back. Only time Van Dyke was up was in the second start when he won at nearly 90-1 at 6F. Never easy to win from the rail at 6.5F on this turf course and that is what he had last out.
