


Footnotes

SECRET STATUS, unhurried into the backstretch while racing between rivals four or five wide, edged in approaching the far turn, came out again to commence her rally five wide between rivals, swung out seven wide when straightened for the drive, was roused sharply lefthanded in the upper stretch, then increased her advantage late when ridden out. RINGS A CHIME went up soon after the start to gain the lead under a long rating hold, raced well removed from the inner railing, settled into the stretch with a clear advantage but wasn't a match for SECRET STATUS in the final furlong. CLASSY CARA, off slowly while breaking inward and brushing the side of the gate, was outrun for six furlongs, began to pick up rivals six or seven wide approaching the stretch and bested the others while off the inside and unable to menace. MISS SEFFENS, well placed from the start and saving ground, made a bold run inside the leaders approaching the final furlong but failed to sustain her bid. ZOFTIG, outrun for six furlongs, made a mild late gain while three or four wide between rivals. BEJOYFULANDREJOYCE leaned in approaching the first turn and bumped repeatedly with KUMARI CONTINENT, settled behind horses, was steadied behind the winner at the five-eighths pole, and not a threat while improving position. SPAIN was ridden early to gain a forward position, stalked the leaders four or five wide, leaned in and bumped with CASH RUN at the three-sixteenths and was empty thereafter. VIVID SUNSET, unloaded when

fractious in the gate, was reloaded, raced forwardly to the far turn and weakened gradually. KUMARI CONTINENT exchanged several bumps with BEJOYFULANDREJOYCE nearing the first turn, was taken eight wide on the backstretch and not a factor. CIRCLE OF LIFE worked her way inside, raced forwardly for six furlongs and weakened thereafter. VELVET MORNING, seven or eight wide much of the way, was never prominent. EDEN LODGE, reluctant to load into the gate, was finished by the end of the backstretch. CASH RUN went up to press the pace at once, held on well until the final quarter, then, when tiring, exchanged bumps with SPAIN at the three-sixteenths. GOLD FOR MY GAL unseated her rider approaching the gate. She raced in a striking position for six furlongs and faded.
