Black Onyx

Beyers going in the right direction, he made the super wide middle move to reach contention in the Spiral and then just kept going; slow to take to the Turfway surface last, he finally got to handling the surface, and was aggressive after about an 8th of a mile; Breen is a very good horseman and he has this runner attempting to do what Animal Kingdom did in parlaying the Spiral to Derby success; he stalked to no avail in the only poor effort but it's never easy to beat winners right back anyway; there is brilliance if you go far enough in the pedigree as you'll find BC Sprint winner and near \$900,000 earner Desert Stormer; he was not exactly flattered by the Rebel show horse who returned to press and fade to 10th; needs very best.

Oxbow

Three poor posts in a row and the trip last time was far from ideal; tough beat to the stablemate in the Rebel and he had to weave his way through traffic last time; the only race he extended in was the LeComite and not sure he was beating anybody that day; pedigree screams distance on both sides as his sire won the Breeder Cup Classic and Oxbow's full brother Awesome Patriot won a stakes at 9 furlongs when he lost a length and a quarter in the lane when recording a 97 Beyer; needs a rebound run.

Revolutionary

Mugged in his debut, was hung wide from his marooned slot next out and then was a tad short in his first try at a mile; he exploded recording the 102 Beyer to graduate, showed agility taking the Withers and his Louisiana Derby win was flattered when Departing returned to win the Illinois Derby; sire and dam both won Grade 1 races and earned over \$2 million combined; half brother Tafaseel was Grade 2 placed and won at 9 furlongs; and if the track is off, this guy has the blood to handle the off going; colt has had the lead or been right there at the top of the lane in three of 6 in his career and 47 of the last 50 Derby winners have been 1st of 2nd with a furlong left; on the 27th, he galloped out in 1:00.58; Borel looking for 4th Derby win; respect.

Golden Soul

Zero for 3 this year but he does figure to be closing; place horse 12/30 returned to hold on by a neck in his maiden breaker but then was out of the money twice; half bro Quintons Gold Rush won the Lexington but was eased at 51-1 in a sloppy Kentucky Derby next out in 2004; kin I Testify won 16 times and did cash in a cheap claimer at 9 furlongs but was never asked to run this far; decent drill on the 26th when he galloped out in 1:14 2/5 and his trainer was pleased, Stewart; "He did it very easy. I really liked the way he galloped out. He finished the last eighth with his ears up in the work, then looked like when he got into the turn, he finished off nicely"; will be in the picture late if at all.

Overanalyze

Near \$400,000 purchase has much more speed than he just showed; his talent surfaced in the Futurity last September and he built on it with a game Remsen win; hung wide from the marooned slot in the Gotham, he made a nice middle move to get within a neck of the lead at the top of the lane in last and then just kept going; the concern is he came home slow last time; the final three furlongs was run in :39.37 and the final time was 2.27 seconds slower than older horses ran in the Oaklawn Handicap 2 races before the Ark Derby; his last race was on the soft side; runner has the blood to star as kin to Grade 1 winner and over \$300K earner Meadow Breeze; 3 weeks since his last race and Pletcher has had success with that kind of spacing in the past.

Palace Malice

They were all on the line in the Blue Grass and that is not always the best of signs; he lost focus that day when distracted by tractor tracks and he was switching leads in the final furlong; runner had a horrible trip in the Louisiana Derby when blocked with traffic surrounding him in the stretch of that race and never got a chance to roll; sired by two-time Horse of the Year who could run all day, his dam won several routes on grass including a stakes; could easily envision him getting a nice stalking trip; too sharp to ignore.

Lines of Battle

Wide from the marooned slot in his other race in the states; in the UAE Derby, this guy was forwardly placed from the sound of the bell, he made the lead and went to drifting a bit, may have been passed briefly by eventual second finisher, but he re-focused and won nicely; Aidan O'Brien has won nearly every huge race in Europe and multiple Breeders' Cup races; runner's sire brought us Fountain of Youth winner Soldat and also Declaration of War, who has won at a mile and quarter on turf and the synthetic; winning dam is a half-sister to Dynaformer, who went on to sire Barbaro; wild card rates upset gamble.

Itsmyluckyday

Colt's stalk and pounce style will allow him to maintain contact and still get first run on the deep closers; nothing wrong with being battle tested and he has only run one poor race when wide at Delta; the raw talent is there, but winning at a mile and a sixteenth and a mile and a quarter are two different universes and he has to prove he can transfer his good Florida form; mile drill on the 18th figures to help his bottom but this trip could be pushing the envelope; if one figures that last race, off a 2-month layoff, was just something he needed, then one could make a case for him to be in the thick of it turning for home; tactical speed may be his best asset.
