Clearly injuries have caught up to him (was off over a year in '18 – '19). Wins if he's feeling good today.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 SPEEDING KID Mn-bred has run some big races at longer odds (2nd a neck three back at 24-1 to next out stakes placed Drop of Golden Sun). He is 2 for 2 this meet first off a claim for this trainer (Campaign Spy and Hotfoot). Started too late in last start. She was getting to the winner who had the better trip. Leading rider will save ground.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 FIRST HUNTER Mn-bred is 7-time winner here on this turf course. She's been in the money in all 3 on the grass here in 2020. Had the rail in last and was unlucky to lose late to the one to her outside. Might clear off in this early on. Back to Eikleberry (up for her last win).</p> <p>VALUE: 3 FLAN Disappointed as the 3-5 favorite off a huge win two back. Was claimed in that race by a trainer with just 5 starts (2 runners). His other claim was Corrana En Limen from a top outfit (Diodoro) who ran 2nd by a head. Came in from AP off a long break in last and won strongly. Might have only won by half a length but he won with something left. 2nd won by 9 next out. He should win by a pole.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 J J'S WILDCAT He took serious money early in the betting in debut despite what looked like an easy winner and the lack of success the trainer had with debut runners. He ran well in the debut. Winner ran 2nd next in a 7k claimer. A) 4 B) 2,3 C) 6</p>
