BURYYOURBELIEF broke sharply, then was allowed to settle just off the early leaders, rallied three wide to challenge midway on the second turn, gained command shortly thereafter, then widened through the stretch under intermittent right handed pressure. HOMETOWN QUEEN, taken in hand early, moved to contention along the inside on the second turn, angled out, split horses in upper stretch, then finished willingly to be clear for the place. SUPER COOK, never far back, swung widest in upper stretch, was forced out a bit by MISS EMPIRE, then could not gain significantly on the top pair. MISS EMPIRE, also well within striking position, swung to the outside entering the stretch, lugged out when steadying off VERY SUBTLE, then had no rally. CHIC SHIRINE alternated for command while saving ground for six furlongs and retired. VERY SUBTLE stumbled at the start, recovered to race forwardly to upper stretch, then gave way. UP THE APALACHEE dueled for command outside, CHIC SHIRINE for three quarters, then faltered. CENTER BOX was not a factor. Start good, ridden out. **Trouble** — VERY SUBTLE stumbled start, SUPER COOK forced out upper stretch. **Time** — :23½, :46½, 1:10½, 1:37, 1:50½.
