Sweeping Story

Flattered when Elaine's Reason returned to run well at KEE last week, but she's a no-figure sort who scored upset last out against much lesser when 20-1; useful filly is over-matched here.

Silverbulletday

Jaw-dropping move in Ashland perhaps most visually impressive 3yo race this year; FG wins to begin this campaign workmanlike, though Beyers still exceptional for 3yo filly; all reports have CD training going as well as it looks on paper, & fondness for CD well-documented; hasn't met stablemate Excellent Meeting since that one's running style changed, and possible she waits behind her today, whereas 'Bullet got jump in '98 BC; belief here is this one has superior turn of foot and can get away from chief rival with her typical turn move; as good as she is, perhaps she's even better in mud; can prove herself among best fillies of recent history with repeat of last and a convincing win.

Excellent Meeting

Strictly an off-the-pace sort as 2yo, but has gained aggressiveness this year; had she been bit sharper in last CD race, she, not 'Bullet, might've been 2yo champ; 96 Beyer in SA Oaks perhaps swept under wake of 106 earned with strong turn move at OP; like 'Bullet, she's outclassed her rivals this year, so hard to know how she'll stand up to stern test; though fact Baffert toying with Derby suggests she's a tough filly; if she wasn't to begin with, barn's workouts have certainly thickened the skin; difficult to separate them, but giving edge to 'Bullet.

Dreams Gallore

Popped big Beyer in Honeybee, her 2nd 2-turn race; made a strong turn move that race, but taxing early pace certainly helped her blow past leaders; 95 Beyer to close 2yo campaign coupled with recent 105 peak suggests there's a graded stakes somewhere out there with her name on it; but beyond issues of class and speed, question whether her best race is at 9fs; pass.

Positive Gal

Cleared n1x last out with below-par Beyer, now tossed to G1 company and asked to go 2 turns for first time; this would be difficult move for the most brilliant of fillies; biggest claim to fame so far is a 5-length maiden win; another good CD work, but she appears overmatched.
