Speed and the rail are a potent combination at Pimlico, and it wouldn't be a surprise to see this hometown hero run and gun from his inside post position; horse for course is perfect over this oval, but has yet to crack 95 on the Beyer scale, and will need a speed figure boost to reach the winner's circle today; dominated weaker competition in the Tesio, but was allowed to glide on an easy early lead, and didn't change leads until late in the stretch; probably won't shake loose here as New York Hero, Peace Rules, and Funny Cide all have good gate speed; Capuano sent out Captain Bodgit to a 3rd-place finish in the 1997 Preakness; pace factor is a proven commodity over a wet racing strip, but think the stalkers/closers will come and get him late; leaning elsewhere for the winner.

Scrimshaw

The Lukas/Lewis partnership had visions of a Charismatic deja vu after their colt won the Lexington, but Scrimshaw failed to fire in the Derby; broke inward from his far outside perch, and was bumped hard at the start; raced in the 4 path going into the 1st turn, and finished in between horses without threatening the top finishers; it's possible he "bounced" in the Derby, and now makes the important 3rd start of the form cycle with a sharp half-mile workout on display; very dangerous to dismiss any Lukas Derby also-ran in the Preakness (both Tank's Prospect and Tabasco Cat rebounded from off-the-board Derby finishes to win the Preakness for the master conditioner); draws nicely, and can sit a nice pace-tracking trip while saving ground; interesting, but might fit best on bottom of exotics.

Foufa's Warrior

One can't help but compare this late-running, long-striding Maryland-bred gelding to 2002 Preakness runnerup Magic Weisner; both won the Maryland Juvenile Championship as 2yos, and both had light Beyer Speed Figures coming into the Preakness; no match for Ten Most Wanted in the Illinois Derby, and wasn't flattered by that rival's subsequent poor Derby showing; rallied powerfully in his grass debut on Kentucky Oaks day, and the expected fast pace would definitely enhance his kick; lightly-raced runner still has upside potential, and has continued to work swiftly; expecting a late charge, but others entice more on the win end.

Acted up a bit before the Wood Memorial as he got away from his lead pony for a short while, but then ran a solid race to equal his Beyer top; saved ground throughout, and finished evenly behind the Derby exacta finishers; probably didn't appreciate the wet, speed-biased conditions at Aqueduct that day, and is in the very capable hands of the underrated Lisa Lewis; had an official 5 furlong company workout on Sunday at Belmont that was obscured by fog; Lewis stated that her colt broke off 8 lengths behind his maiden stablemate, and finished 3 in front; should be fresh after skipping the demanding 10 furlongs of the Derby; undefeated over fast going, he is another that would appreciate a quick pace; can factor at a nice price.

Ohio-bred works bullets in the mornings, but doesn't show much speed in his races; fell far behind in the early going of the Derby, but advanced along the inside entering the far turn before going very wide at the top of the stretch; passed some tired rivals en route to his 8th-place finish; Lukas remains undaunted despite the fact this colt has been beaten a combined 88 1/4 lengths in his last 4 starts; hasn't moved forward since dead-heating Senor Swinger in a Gulfstream allowance although he reportedly had some tooth problems that needed to be addressed; connections replaced P. Val with Bailey at the last minute once Champali defected; pace scenario plays into this late-runner's hooves, and it's tough to ignore a Lukas runner at a juicy mutuel; price play?

Don't be too concerned about the light AN2X Beyer as he was geared down completely for the last 1/16-1/8th of a mile; Howard won the Preakness with Summer Squall in 1990, and doesn't usually place his horses in overly-ambitious spots so it's a vote of confidence that he makes his G1 debut in this Classic event; can show continued improvement in his 3rd start of the form cycle, but his previous stakes races haven't been too pretty, and he will get a true class test here; owns excellent tactical speed, and should be within striking range down the backstretch; can't fault anyone that will take a nice price on a lightly-raced, improving colt from top connections; not the worst stab.

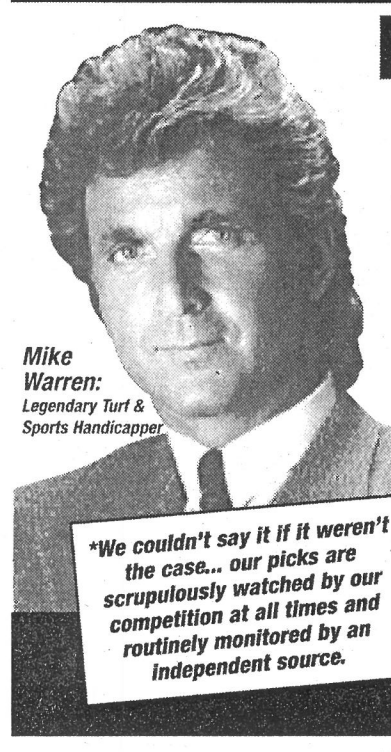

Might have the best early speed of the bunch, but the connections have been adamant in stating that they want him to rate; skipped the Derby for the 1-turn Withers, and didn't have the easiest time of it that day; bumped at the start, then rushed up to contest a hot pace; was under the whip 2 1/2 furlongs out, however, and failed to rally while in behind horses in the stretch; failed to take advantage of a speed-biased track in the Wood 2 back, and was drifting out badly in the stretch of his Lane's End score in March; Beyers pale in comparison to those of the top contenders, but he is lightly-raced with plenty of scope for improvement; think he'll be in the thick of things from the start, but must show greater stamina to defeat these; searching elsewhere for the winner.

Funny Cide

The pride of New York overcame some hurdles to take the Derby as the 1st NY-bred winner, and the 1st gelding since old Clyde Van Dusen (1929) to capture the Roses; now, he must handle another dangerous obstacle in his quest for the Triple Crown - his outside post position (posts 8 and out are 1-51 in route races at this meet going into Thursday); came out a bit at the start of the Derby, but then sat a great trip tracking a solid pace battle down the backstretch; leapt into action on the far turn, and held sway gamely in the stretch despite changing back to his wrong lead late; one must wonder if he will be adversely affected by those 2 grueling races in the Wood and Derby, but fears of a 'bounce' were somewhat allayed when he worked a bullet half-mile on 5/13; has the tactical speed to gain a good attack position, and should be commencing his rally as the field hits the far turn; obviously a major danger, but demand mutual value.

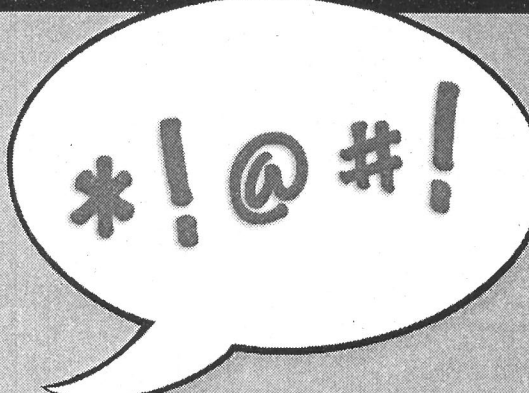
