**1 1/2 MILES. (2:24)** 135th Running of THE BELMONT. Grade I. Purse \$1,000,000 (Up To \$72,000 NYSBFOA). THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$600 each to accompany the nomination if made on or before January 18, 2003, or \$6,000 if made on or before March 29 2003, \$10,000 to pass the entry box and \$10,000 additional to start. At any time prior to the closing time of entries, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$100,000 to The New York Racing Association Inc. The Purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Colts and Geldings, 126 lbs.; Fillies, 121 lbs. Starters to be named at the closing time of entries. The Belmont field will be limited to sixteen (16) starters.

## A CLOSER LOOK

### Belmont Stakes

#### Empire Maker

What a difference 5 weeks makes! After the Wood Memorial, many fans were anointing this regally-bred colt as the next Triple Crown winner; now he is relegated to the role of a possible spoiler as Funny Cide guns for the glory; while brilliantly dominant in the Florida Derby and Wood Memorial, he had problems with his lead changes; under the Twin Spires, however, he was a total professional; after an abbreviated final week of preparation due to a bruised foot, he raced in a bit tight going past the wire the 1st time, then made a nice wide move to reach the leaders on the far turn; he changed leads on cue, and rallied evenly for the place; Frankel and Bailey have been exuding confidence, claiming that they wouldn't want to trade places with anyone going into the Belmont; although idle since the Derby, it is very possible that Empire Maker is now a healthier and more mentally mature racehorse; owns very competitive Beyers, and has a win over Funny Cide on his resume; expect Bailey to sit just off Scrimshaw and Funny Cide, and he will probably make his move when he sees Funny Cide gear up on the turn; a very dangerous competitor that must be given a great deal of respect.

#### Supervisor

The longshot in the Belmont field finished ahead of Funny Cide in the Holy Bull at Gulfstream earlier in the year, but hasn't moved forward off of that performance; has yet to reach 90 on the Beyer scale, and all of the horses he'll be facing today have eclipsed 100; has not cracked the exacta in his 8 previous stakes outings, and will be getting a stern class test against these top notch sophomores; late-running style would be aided by solid fractions, but he will need a complete pace collapse to pull off the shocker; respect these connections, but this colt looks like he is in way too steep; others entice more.

#### Scrimshaw

Consecutive double-digit defeats by Funny Cide have taken some of the luster off the Lexington winner; ran a similar race as Ten Most Wanted in the Derby as he broke from an outside post, was bumped at the start, and raced wide without threatening; can't complain about his Preakness trip; pressed Peace Rules for the 1st quarter of a mile while racing on the deeper inside paths, eased off the lead to stalk in between horses, and finished evenly despite drifting in during the stretch; it is always unwise to dismiss a Lukas runner in a Triple Crown race; remember how the Hall of Fame trainer transformed Commendable from a Kentucky Derby also-ran to a Belmont winner; might have the best early speed of this group, and it would not be a surprise to see Stevens have this guy on the front end; may get very brave if allowed to slow down the tempo, but he must improve to turn the tables on Funny Cide and Empire Maker; leaning elsewhere.

**Funny Cide**  
 Secretariat; Count Fleet; Seattle Slew; Citation; Affirmed; Funny Cide is only 12 furlongs away from joining these and 6 other legends of the turf as Triple Crown Champions; standing in his way this afternoon will not only be his 5 rivals on the track, but the shadows of Spectacular Bid, Pleasant Colony, Alysheba, Sunday Silence, Silver Charm, Real Quiet, Charismatic, and War Emblem; those 8 paraded into New York on the cusp of immortality only to be stymied by 'The Test Of The Champion'; Funny Cide has already overcome many obstacles on his historic quest; he became the 1st NY-bred, and 1st gelding since 1929 to wear the Roses, and he captured the Preakness after breaking from a very difficult outside post position; Funny Cide's greatest asset is his excellent tactical speed; in the Derby, he deftly avoided the crush of horses careening into the 1st turn, and settled snugly in the perfect tracking position; at Pimlico, he comfortably perched outside the pace-setters before unleashing a devastating burst that left his rivals in the wake of his brilliance; neighsayers will note that Funny Cide has the annoying habit of changing back to his wrong lead in the stretch, and that his pedigree is ill-suited to the demanding Belmont distance; form cycle theorists will wonder if he is primed for a 'bounce' after 3 taxing races coupled with a pair of blistering recent workouts; there's no denying his Beyer superiority, or his affinity for this racing strip, however, and he projects for a great tracking trip just off probable pacesetter Scrimshaw; Funny Cide should get the jump on his competition, and figures to be prominently-placed when they turn for home; has a huge chance to snatch the Crown.

**Dynever**  
 This lightly-raced colt may have the most visually impressive stretch kick of any 3yo; burst onto the scene with his Aventura tally; rallied wide in tandem with Supah Blitz that day, lost the lead in upper stretch, but roared home the final 1/8th of a mile to win as much the best; don't take much stock in his light Lone Star Derby Beyer as he only ran an 1/8th of a mile in that event; saved ground going into the 1st turn, and raced in and among horses on the backstretch before being hopelessly blocked at the 1/4 pole; undaunted, he exploded through a narrow seam to win going away; Prado ruined War Emblem's dreams of Triple Crown glory last year when he upset the apple cart aboard longshot Sarava; had some foot problems in the days leading up to the Belmont; trained in a bar shoe, and one must wonder if his late charge will be affected by the injury; has plenty of upside potential, and acts like a runner that will relish this distance; should get enough pace to setup his rally; a very interesting contender, but demand mutuel value before taking the plunge at the windows.

**Ten Most Wanted**  
 He was the 'Wise Guy's' darling in the Derby, but never threatened in a disappointing effort; was bumped hard at the start, and then was sandwiched a few strides out of the gate; raced 4 wide most of the way, and finished evenly without gaining on the top 3; reportedly had some back problems after the Derby, but shows solid workouts, and a repeat of that 110 Beyer earned against weaker in the Illinois Derby would put him in the hunt; looked good at Hawthorne as he ran up onto heels on the far turn, but wasn't fazed in the least, and went on to post a decisive score; think his stout pedigree will allow him to handle the distance, and he doesn't have to be too far off the lead (close to the pace in both the Sham and the El Camino Real Derby); capable of a decent stalking trip while in the clear about 6-8 lengths off the leaders before commencing his rally on the final turn; not out of this as a value play.

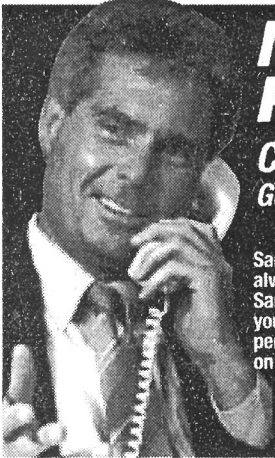
