There is no grass pedigree on either side of the lineage. Was strong with Cal-breds prior to the turf try. Really spread them in the Real Good Deal. Has speed but doesn't need the lead to win this race. Excellent 5F move since the last time out.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 8 THE BIG WAM</b> Hasn't been out since the 2022 G1 Del Mar Futurity some 13 months ago. The trainer won 3 of his last 8 coming in off a layoff of 250 days or more. Gets first Lasix and that might mean he bled in last start. Beat Kangaroo Court 3 back and that one beat the top choice twice. Winner of last was beaten a neck in the G2 City of Hope here on Saturday at 9-1. He's on his 8<sup>th</sup> racetrack in 10 career starts. Moves forward here 2<sup>nd</sup> off the break.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 11 CARMELITA'S MAN</b> Qualifies for this race despite having won 8 times and is in off a stakes win. The reason is most of his wins have come in Cal-bred races. Runner-up from last returned to win a stakes at LRC. Been in the exacta in 8 of 18 here at Santa Anita. Clearly the class of the field today for one of the top trainers in the country.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 4 ACCRETIVE</b> Seems the most likely if the top choice should go down today. He's won 3 of 5 for Chad Brown (although the two losses are the only two without Lasix). Won her lone start on the AQU dirt in her debut by over 8 lengths. Test for class in here.</p> <p><b>VALUE: 2 STERLING SILVER</b> Not sure what happened in the last start but she didn't run much in that G1 on the muddy track. She's run well here (3 wins in 5 starts) and has two wins with this rider (Castellano) aboard in the just the last 5 starts. She will have to improve to compete.
