The winner won the G2 San Vicente next for Mark Glatt. 2 others won MSW and yet another ran second in the G2 Los Al Futurity. Winner of 2nd start 2 for 2 for Baffert after winning a 217k stakes at CD next.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 REFOCUS This is the female family of the '03 G1 Test winner, Lady Tak. They paid \$625k for her so there are expectations. She had a poor start in the debut and was in tight in a few places. Blinkers on and Lasix is added. This one is coming off a dominant win here. Notice the runner-up was another 6 clear of third. This is a Northern Dancer female line that includes Storm Bird. Casse trained the dam who was stakes placed for the same owner in 2019.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 MAXIMUM OFFER Added Lasix for her three-year old debut and she won. She was also getting blinkers for the first time. Showed some talent with a longshot third in the first start when in MSW company at Keeneland. Sib to a 355k turf sprint winner, Stealhediamonds. McPeek does well in these stakes at Oaklawn Park. He has just 3 starts but fired in all 3. Jose Ortiz was aboard in the first two starts (beaten a half and a victory at CD. Closed well for second at 3-1 last time out. The winner was the 6-5 favorite who got a 107 Beyer. Dam was a G1 winning router for Asmussen. Will keep moving forward.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 HYMN Came off a long layoff three back and ran a career best when a runner-up at CD from the widest 9 post. He may not have liked the sloppy track two back and was sans Lasix in the last start. Still too lightly raced to gauge his real talent. Did win his debut here at 6F as the 3-1 fav a year ago. <p>10 – OAKLAWN PARK (5:04 ET) 84 BULGER 135K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>8 BLUE FIRE 5-2 5 FOIE GRAS 3-1 3 PISTOL 12-1 2 HARBOR SPRINGS 15-1</p> <p>PICK: 8 BLUE FIRE La-bred is expertly spotted by Steve Asmussen in here. The race is restricted to those who have not won stakes other than statebred or restricted. This filly has won 4 stakes and was second in the G2 8Belles at CD 4 starts ago. Jose Ortiz is 4 for 6 riding here (two losses were in stakes). Great speed but can sit just off the pace if needed.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 PISTOL Added blinkers in her most recent start (an opt 100k at CD back at the end of November). She won that race at nearly 54-1. She is 5 for 19 at the distance. Has enough speed to get good position and draws well to the inside part of the track. She can press or sit behind and look for one late move. He drew widest but went off at 9-5. That price was a gift considering how he ran. Consider a stakes on that day was run in 1:11 and an allowance in 1:11.2. So that 1:09.2 was blazing. Sire known for sprinters but he did have Olympiad (won the G1 Jockey Club at 1M 1/4).</p> <p>VALUE: 11 SILENT TACTIC Runner-up finish in the Smarty Jones was better than it looked. The winner was sitting up on a dawdling pace in :49.3 and 1:14.4. This one had to close into the slow pace. He sold for 500k last year. Mark Casse has 4 wins and a runner-up finish in his last 5 stakes starts on this Oaklawn Park track. That includes a 1M 3/16 win here 5 starts ago when he drew off by nearly 6 lengths. He's 3 for 4 at OP. Likely gets the run of the race as the pace should be contested and on the quick side. Major rider change from an apprentice who was up in last. Form is good. Sure likes to win races.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 CYBERTOWN One of the deeper closers in here. Gets in very light in terms of weight carried due to the apprentice rider up. Last was simply a prep to get started at this meet. He's an Ark-bred who has been in the money in 10 of 19 over this dirt track. Should get some speed to run into.
