PICK: 1 INSUBORDINATION
 Trainer George Weaver is 2 for last 7 (29%) with 4 in the top two (57%) with a first time 2YO routing on turf in MSW here at SAR. The winners were 6-1, 9-2. The runner-ups were both just over 20-1. One of the winners was ridden by Cancel. This is turf on turf breeding. Notice the solid 4F move a week ago.

VALUE: 3 CLEVER AGAIN
 500k purchase last September was impressive in the debut at KEE sprinting on the dirt. He gave a first time Wesley Ward 1-2 favorite a race and they were well clear of the rest. Dam is a full sib to the 5-time Euro Group 1 winner, Love. She won nearly \$2M on turf. Sire had G1 turf winner, Harvey's Lil Goil.

PICK: 5 IT TAKES HEART
 Trainer Falcone is 12 for 38 (32%) with 27 in the money (71%) when dropping in half (or more) in claiming price and on the dirt. That includes a win at this meet with Empty Tomb as a 7-1 upsetter a few weeks ago. 4th place finisher from the last start won a 40k claimer at AQU by over 7-lengths next start.

VALUE: 3 MY FIRST LOVE
 There are many question marks on the major players in here. This one is, at least, fairly honest for this level. She dropped in class or the last start and ran a solid second at 5-1. She's nibbled vs. high class so this 16k level should be ideal. She'll be sitting off the pace and look to make a late run in this one.

 Gets a pretty significant rider move to Velazquez for this. He has outrun his odds but hasn't really challenged for the win yet. Comes out of the same race as the rail runner who might go off favored. This one was 3 behind that one but his speed was dulled on the cutback. Think he'll be overlooked in here.

VALUE: 7 MAZZEI
 Both starts on the turf and the pedigree indicates he should love the grass. Beat 6 foes in the debut when he ran evenly as a 14-1 longshot. The winner of that race had been 2nd two straight races, went off favored in that win, and returned to win an allowance at AQU. Rider was up for trainer's win here.

Blinkers came back in last and he ran and hid at 25-1. Very wide post off the layoff 3 back was difficult to overcome. Stumbled at the start 4 back and had a troubled trip on a sloppy track in the second career start.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 BOSS TWEED Finally carried his speed in the maiden win on the class drop two back. Bettors weren't convinced and allowed him to go off at 9-1 in the last start, in a 5-horse field, but he showed ability there. The runner-up won back at 3-5 in the same str allw level. Two bullet 3F moves since last. Always have to take notice of a Linda Rice runner in New York. This one made a nice move to get third at nearly 10-1 last out. He was wide in there and lost ground with the trip last out and also two back. Rice is excellent with major class droppers. Will be tough in this one.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 VIN SANTO Faced better in the last two starts and did little but had some excuses. Turf from the 10 post and a wide trip last time was difficult to overcome at that level. Faced allw company on a sloppy track two back. Ny-bred has run well at times and may like the distance. Joe Sharp runners have been in the top two finishers in 3 of 5 so far this meet. Added blinkers in last. Gets Lasix back in the fold here.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 RECONCILE She's beaten just 12 runners in the four starts but all but one of those were in stakes. She makes her first start on the turf. Her sire (War Front) is a significant turf influencer. The female family goes back to Broodmare of the Year, Weekend Surprise (dam of Summer Squall and AP Indy). <p>7 - SARATOGA (3:54 ET) 79 MAIDEN SPECIAL WEIGHT 100K, 6F DIRT</p> <p>2 AUTHENTIC GALLOP 8-1 10 SOCIAL HOUR 6-1 3 DAPPER MOON 8-1 5 PERFECT FORCE 8-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 AUTHENTIC GALLOP Amoss won his only start for this owner on this track in MSW sprinting on the dirt for a 2YO. That came last year. That was at 8-1, with Gaffalione, and sporting an almost identical set of works at CD/SAR. Female line produced a G3 dirt winner Ami's Flatter, and Amis Gizmo, 2nd in the \$1M Queens Plate.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 SOCIAL HOUR Female family of Albertus Maximus, a G1 dirt router and the G1 Champagne winner (as a 2YO), Daredevil, who was trained by Pletcher. Sire is excellent with debut 2YO's and with dirt sprinters. Connections paid 500k for him last year. Rider is up as Pletcher's top call riders are at MTH. The dam is a sib to both Saint Liam (\$4.4M earner) and Quiet Giant (the dam of Gun Runner who won \$15M). Did not have Lasix in the G2 last out and he faded. Gets Lasix back and looks like the controlling speed. Never off the board with Lasix for trainer Linda Rice.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 DEER DISTRICT Has a turfy pedigree and that is why the connections keep him in turf races. But he is G2 placed on the dirt and has earned nearly 140k on the main track. Alvarado gets aboard. He was up for back to back longshot in the money finishes in Ky last year. Could carve out a nice trip behind the pace in this spot.</p> <p>A) 2,3,5 B) 4,7 C) 8,9 D) 1</p>	<p>9 - SARATOGA (5:04 ET) 68 OPTIONAL CLAIMING 120K, 1M 1/8 TURF</p> <p>2 MAJOR DUDE 3-1 5 ATONE 4-1 6 CASH EQUITY 8-1 8 ANDTHEWINNERIS 5-1</p> <p>PICK: 2 MAJOR DUDE This is a 3-time graded stakes winner on the grass. He's only had two races that were subpar. One was on the quirky grass course at KD two back (sans Lasix) and the other in the Grade 1 BC Juv Turf (beaten 4-lengths from the 13 post). Couldn't run down a loose leader setting slow fractions in his most recent start.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 CASH EQUITY Saffie Joseph has been red-hot lately. He is 30 for 109 (28%) in the last month at all tracks (60% in the money). It includes a win in his only start at this meet. Gets extra credit last time out when he closed into a crawling pace that was being set by the winner, and ended up very wide. Pace is the question.</p> <p>A) 2,5,6 B) 1,8,9 C) 3,4 D)</p>

<p>PICK: 3 MANAMA GOLD No disgrace in the runner-up finish to an undefeated (3 for 3) winner last out. It was clearly a prep for longer. Winner of the UAE Oaks rather easily when ridden out at 1M 3/16. Has two sibs who won a combined 8 for 11 on the grass. Must have really impressed in the work on the turf. She can be any kind.</p> <p>VALUE: 8 POUNCE Before the last start at Penn National, the only two losses for this one came on a good turf track as the favorite and on the synthetic at TP. Might have gone a bit fast on the lead in the Penn Oaks. Thought the win from off the pace in the G3 at GP 3 back was excellent. Might try rating a bit under Dylan Davis.</p> <p>A) 2,3 B) 4,6,7,8 C) 1,5,10 D) 9</p>		<p>PICK: 3 THORPEDO ANNA Modest purchase is simply the best filly of her generation at this point. She just dominated her foes in all 5 wins. Trouble early and midrace cost her the win in the Golden Rod. She's able to get into the race quickly but also has a devastatingly strong late run. That style gives Hernandez many trip options.</p> <p>VALUE: 4 LESLIE'S ROSE She was a rather surprising G1 winner of the Ashland at KEE 3 back. Took money in the G1 Kentucky Oaks won by the top choice but the 13 post and sloppy track hurt her chances in that one. Solid runner-up finish to Thorpedo Anna in the G1 Acorn. Show filly won the G3 Delaware Oaks in her next start.</p> <p>A) 3 B) 1,4 C) 5 D)</p>		<p>PICK: 6 VINTAGE VINO There is significant distance breeding here. Sire on the dam side was a multiple G1 winner at 1M 1/2 (won the 2011 G1 Arlington Million and G1 Turf Classic). Sire won the 2019 G1 BC Classic. Drew the rail in both starts. Had very little chance to close into such a slow pace in last. Blinkers come on here.</p> <p>VALUE: 5 EL REZEEN Got no help from the post draw in the last three starts. Got a very wide trip last out and ran in place late. Pletcher puts on the blinkers for this one. Put in 4 works since the last start at AQU. He did miss a work from 6/15 to 6/29.
