

ON THIS DATE (2000) – THATSUSINTHEOLBEAN was a superstar for trainer Doug Oliver and owner Nadine Andreas. He won 7 of his 16 starts at Canterbury Park and was voted the 1999 Horse of the Year. On August 12, 2000, he won for the final time at Canterbury, in an allowance by 4-lengths. He won 452k and is one of 15 horses in the CBY Hall of Fame.
