Folklore She had a strong string of works leading up to the Matron and she certainly ran to them, drawing off to win by the length of the stretch; 5/2 against that field, though, was one thing; she's 5/2 on the ML here despite never having tried this distance, and coming off a Beyer top; in the Matron, it didn't hurt that race favorite India banged her head hard on the gate in a pre-start mishap, and was eventually eased; she's stuck inside here, which may force Prado's hand a bit, and since this is her 1st try past 7f it's anyone's guess if she'll be able to rate at this distance; she can certainly win, of course, but at an undervalued price we'll try to beat her, at least on top.

Original Spin She took full advantage of a perfect trip from jockey Jesse Campbell behind a quick, contested pace in the Arlington Lassie and that was the difference; no surprise she's showing ability early on, as she's a full sister to Humor At Last, who won a couple of stakes races at 2; she's perfectly drawn here and figures to again enjoy ideal position, this time under Bailey; barn has a 23% win percentage and a plus ROI with 1st-Lasix users over the last 5 years.

Proven over the track, a plus and she comes off a sharp score in the Frizette, granted it was over a sloppy track, but the fact that she was able to rally and make one run is important, since she'll need to do the same here given the expected pace scenario; the expected pace scenario, dam's 2 other winners both best as sprinters, and this filly will need to run faster to win this, as her best Beyer to date is a 93, so the \$1 ML might be considered by some to be an underlay.

**She Says It Best**

Wired the field in the Alcibiades when she was able to get loose but there are 2 clear knocks: the race didn't produce that strong of a Beyer, and the Keeneland strip is carrying speed as much as ever this fall; there's little doubt regarding her strategy here, as she's the type that wants to be on the lead, but she's going to be hard-pressed to put away the speed and stave off the closers without a big step forward.

**Ex Caelis**

Beaten favorite in her last couple of starts, and she finished behind a couple of these, but she had excuses; two back she was behind Original Spin but she moved prematurely there and did well to hold the place; last time, she was wide and off the pace on a track that is extremely tough on closers; she in fact ran quite well to get 2nd, making a run on the turn while wide, and her recent works suggest she's coming into this BC in great shape; given the way this one shapes up, with several speeds in the line-up, she might be the right closer, especially at 15-1 on the ML.

**Wild Fit**

She could not put away Diamond Omi last time despite the fact that that rival was under pressure from the start, and she's now regressed with each start in terms of Beyers; have to wonder it's a coincidence that those races have gotten longer with each start; the good news is that she fits the race as a closer, since the pace figures to be quick, but she'll need to turn things around to get there first even with a clean trip off rapid splits.

Ivan Denisovich (IRE)

He is a three-quarter brother to Breeders' Cup Mile hero War Chant (a Grade 2 winner on dirt), and is a half to turf stakes-winner Double Cat (153K), and multiple SW Ministers Wild Cat (368K); his dam won the Breeders' Cup Distaff among her twelve victories so there is plenty of dirt ability in his pedigree; high-class sire gets about 12% winners on the all-weather tracks in Europe (according to The Racing Post); 'Ivan' may not have cared for the soft ground he encountered in his last 2 starts, and he looked good swooping past the field to win the July Stakes in the summer; tries a route and dirt for the first time, and has been a bit green on occasion; O'Brien won this race with Johannesburg in 2001; demand value before taking the plunge.

Leo (GB)

1/2 to Italian 2yo SW Balkenhol was aided by a moderate pace to win a subpar renewal of the Royal Lodge Stakes at Newmarket; long-striding sort picks up the always-dangerous Frankie Dettori, and has the tactical speed to sit a nice trip in the second flight or so; acts like he'll stay this extra distance, but there is a lot of turf pedigree in the family (second dam won the British 1,000 Guineas), and he simply may be better-suited to the grass; sire gets about 12% winners on the all-weather track, but this looks like a tough test for the main track debut run.

Set Alight

1/2 to multiple G2 turfer True Flare, multiple French stakes-winner River Flare, G2 winner Apple of Kent, German G3 winner Capital Secret, and multiple G3 turfer War Zone has tons of early speed, and figures to be prominent in the early stages; dam was stakes-placed in France, but sire Hennessy finished second in this race in 1995, and has 'nicked' well with Mr. Prospector mares (SW Handsome Hunk, etc); he's hard to hold in the early stages, and would not be well-served by battling it out on the front end today; taking a wait-and-see approach as the distance is a question.

Lightly-raced colt has a great deal of upside potential, but was a bit eager in his first start going a route of ground at Oak Tree; he pulled himself into the race early, but stayed on well in the lane considering the reports that he may have displaced his palate that day; he Beyer Speed Figures are a bit light when compared with those of the top contenders, but his stalking style plays well in this heat, and he is trained by one of Southern California's top conditioners; still a maiden, he's giving up lots of experience in this spot; originally sold for \$50K as a yearling; leaning elsewhere for the winner.

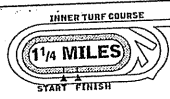

Wonder Again

Winless a long time and she clearly wants the ground as soft as possible; great sign that she was back to best in latest when just missing on firm turf; the barn has had tough luck this meet and regular rider Prado is just 3-for-22 this year for this top turf outfit; she figures to be a huge factor in the lane, but hard to expect a victory in this spot after so many near misses; underneath.

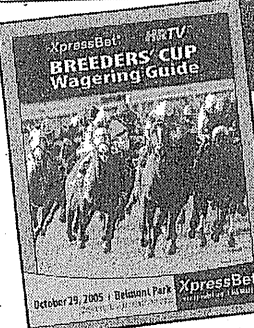
