Peter Miller 8% with firsters. But he's won 2 of last 4 in debut and another was 2nd a length. One win was here at DMR and other at 29-1 at ELP (both 2YO's). Bred to be fast, sire Jackie's Warrior. Female line goes back to '95 G1 BC Juv Fillies winner My Flag and superstar champion Personal Ensign. Rosario 2 for last 3 (another ran 2nd) in last 3 rides for Miller (all at DMR).

VALUE: 6 BOSS MAN BOLT

Hit the board in both starts. The debut was against open class MSW company. The winner and runner-up were spread out well clear of the rest. This one started to run late and get third by a neck in a decent run at 31-1. The winner is the top choice in the G3 Best Pal (race 3) today. Found his friends in the most recent start when beaten a neck at 9-1. Certainly figures here.

Euro bloodlines for this 3YO filly. She was off slow in the first US start but finished pretty well to get within two lengths in the end. Thought she deserved better in her last start after she got in tight. She still finished well. There are sprinters in this race stretching out so she might get the right trip. Win 2 back over cheaper was very good. Haven't seen her best here.

VALUE: 2 HANNAH BUCKLE

This is another who is in for the tag. She has a great record on this turf (2 wins in 5 starts). Both of her wins here came at the distance of today, 1 mile. Winner of her last start won the 100k Osunitas here on July 25th at 7-1. Good to see Ayuso back up as he rode her in both of her wins. Like the top choice she will get plenty of speed to set up her late run. Well-spotted today.

This colt was awesome in the debut. He never gave that field a chance at any point. Sire was a G1 winning sprinter (he won the Woody Stephens in 2021. Runner-up in the win was one for Bob Baffert who ran second in a MSW here on July 25th at 3-1. Third was second by a neck in a mdn opt clm 150k at 9-1 here on July 17th. 92 Beyer by far the fastest in debut for Cerin.

VALUE: 5 YOU WANT SOME

This is definitely a win-early pedigree. Sire Volatile gets 14% with two-year old debut runners. He is the sire of TO Elvis, the colt who took the G1 CD by storm on Derby Day when he won by over 3 with a 108 Beyer. Dam was a multiple stakes winner sprinting and routing. The last 4 times that Peter Miller sent out a firster, he won twice and was 2nd by a length in another.

Michael McCarthy took over 3 other runners from Chad Brown for this ownership. One of those won a stakes and the other two ran third in the first start with McCarthy, all in So Cal. Has not been worse than 4th since 2024. Winner of the last start came back to win the G2 Beverly D at Colonial last weekend (3 graded stakes in a row). 5th three back won a G3 and a length back in a G1 after.

VALUE: 6 WARMING

She has two wins and a good third in her last three starts going long on the grass. The third came last out when she broke from the rail and rallied into a slow pace. She won a G3 here in So Cal back in Oct with JJ Hernandez aboard. Trainer Graham Motion is having a pretty solid season. He does well when he ships them in from the East Coast. She is 2 for 2 at the distance. A viable player.

Phil D'Amato is 11 for 35 (31%) with 24 in the money (69%) with one making their second start in the US in a MSW on the turf. Many of those winners were off the board in the first US start. This one beat 12 foes going 1M 1/4 in the debut in IRE in Feb. He was flat late in the first stateside start. Blinkers come on and he was gelded since last start. Big rider Hernandez up.

VALUE: 8 HAZAKA

Looks very similar to the top choice. Also makes his 3rd start for Phil D'Amato and was in the same race as the top choice in his first start in the US. He was 6-1 and pulling early but he was able to hold 4th beaten just 4 lengths. Sire won the 2020 G1 Diamond Jubilee at Royal Ascot. D'Amato put many drills into him since the last start in May. Gets Rispoli up for this one.

Claimed for 25k in his last start. The trainer Papaprodromou has won 30% first time off the claim over the last 5 years (31 wins with 105 starts). He won 9 of his last 21 first off the claim (43%). This one just beat open class. The two who've run back from there won (5th in 10k clm at 6-1, 7th beat 16k clm at 4-1). Rispoli has won 28% at Del Mar for this trainer in last 2 years.

VALUE: 4 SUPERNAL

Claimed from the last start for this price of 20k. He sat nicely just off the speed, took control and drew off in the end as the 8-5 favorite when still with Doug O'Neill. He's been in the top two in 5 of 7 on a fast dirt track. Has enough speed to gather himself in a good spot tracking the speed. He's won 3 of his 5 at the distance. Will be a fair price in an evenly matched race.

While we may equate sire Mr. Big for longer distances, he has a very good record with debut 2YO's. He stands at the farm of this owner and he has had quite a few win first out (12% overall). He has teamed up with Tim Yakteen in some of those wins. Fresu is first call for a couple of trainers in here but he opts here. He's won 36% for Yakteen at Del Mar. Works are sharp. Looks like in here.

VALUE: 8 TAKE REVENGE

She was the 7-2 favorite in her debut. She didn't run terribly but hardly make a dent from off the pace. She was wide from a wide post. The last 8 second time starters on the dirt for this trainer have produced 2 wins and 7 in the money. Both winners were in MSW with JJ Hernandez aboard and with runners who were off the board in the debut. Sib to stakes winner Curlin's Koas (7F dirt).

He has routed on the turf (all at 1M) four times and been in the money in three of them. That includes the last two at this 50k level. He was beaten a half two back and really overcame a bit of trouble (running up on heels) and jus tmissed. He seems to be better without blinkers. He has many works for the return (off two months). Should be able to sit behind a fast early pace.

VALUE: 3 LUCKY SNIPER

He ran pretty well at 14-1 in the debut at 6.5F on the turf over at Santa Anita. He was in a bit tight in there but finished well to be beaten just over 3-lengths. Something went wrong last time out as he just never got into the race. He's been off since May and comes back as a new gelding. Slight drop should be able to help some. Sire Om was at his best at the 1M distance.
