

ON THIS DATE (2007) – GLITTER STAR is one of 15 horses in the Canterbury Hall of Fame. She was a 6-time stakes winner at Canterbury Park. On August 19, 2007, Glitter Star won the Minnesota Distaff for the 3rd straight year (tied with Crocrock as only 3x winners of a stakes race on Festival of Champions Day). The last race today is named for Glitter Star.
