Pine Bluff Worked his way to the outside after coming away in close quarters, advanced while racing five wide on the backstretch, continued his rally into the stretch, brushed with Dance Floor inside the final furlong and finished strongly to wear down Alydeed.

Alydeed Away in good order, raced outside Speakerphone while prompting the pace into the backstretch, caught that rival nearing the far turn and, after opening a clear lead through the upper stretch, wasn't able to withstand the winner.

Casual Lies Between horses early while in hand, moved around Technology and Speakerphone leaving the far turn, angled to the inside to continue his rally near midstretch and finished with good energy.

Dance Floor Quickly reached striking position from the outside, went after the leaders approaching the end of the backstretch, remained prominent to the upper stretch, brushed with Pine Bluff inside the final furlong and weakened.

Lil E. Tee Bumped shortly after the start, was sent up along the inside entering the backstretch, angled out after starting the far turn,

was wide into the stretch but failed to seriously menace and bled.

Technology In close after the start, then steadied along between horses racing to the first turn, rallied between horses nearing the far turn but had nothing left for the drive.

Agincourt Rank while trying to get out through the run to the first turn and around the first turn, failed to be a serious factor.

Dash for Dotty Outrun after being bothered by Fortune's Gone following the start, raced very wide during the late stages.

Careful Gesture Was always outrun.

Fortune's Gone Broke to the inside forcing Dash for Dotty into Lil E. Tee and was finished early.

Big Sur Saved ground while racing forwardly until near the end of the backstretch and gave way.

My Luck Runs North Lacked room between horses soon after the start and was never close.

Conte Di Savoya In close after the start, raced six wide into the backstretch and failed to reach contention.

Speakerphone Quickly sprinted clear, raced well out from the rail while speed to the far turn and stopped suddenly.
