PICK: 6 CASHMEUP Claimed out of the debut for 75k and he ran very well for second first off the claim. The winner has won 3 times since for Brad Cox including two \$200k stakes races on the turf. Trainer has won 7 and been second 3 times last 15 starts (10 for 15 in the exacta, 67%). Gets 1 st time Lasix.			PICK: 8 LADY CHAI Sire Kantharos gets 17% with dirt sprinters overall and 14% with 2YO first-time starters. Trainer DeVaux has the half sibling Tarabi in training. She was 3 rd in the 2021 BC Juvenile Filly and 2nd in the 2022 G3 Dogwood at 7F last Sep at CD. DeVaux 23% debut 2YO in MSW dirt sprinting.			PICK: 4 TWO ITEM SAVER Nothing wrong with the debut a year ago at CD. She was 37-1 in there but closed in well to finish 4 th within 4.5 of the winner. That winner has won 3 stakes including the G2 Golden Rod for Tom Amoss. Sharp win at CNL. Second in there was 12 clear of third and won a CD MSW next out.			
VALUE: 2 PEEK Candy Ride colt hasn't been on a fast dirt track yet. Can excuse the last two starts. Kentucky Downs isn't always a track that horses like. Shuffled two back and lost a bit of ground in there. Trainer is 1 for 3 going MSW to a mdn clm 100-150k race. A bullet work on this dirt before last.			VALUE: 2 SISTER ELLA This is sprint on sprint breeding with Mitole (2019 G1 BC Sprint winner) on top and the dam by Orientate (2022 G1 BC Sprint winner). Asmussen is 27 for 157 (17%) in a MSW sprint on dirt at 6F for 2YO's (having won 3 of last 6 with that angle and 2 for 2 on that angle with this ownership).			VALUE: 4 TWO ITEM SAVER Assumes a prominent role due to the defections in this race. Debut was a tossout due to the stumble and fade at 11-1. Stretched out and romped in the second start at FG (which was the first with Saez who is back today). Has a perfect set of CD drills. Trainer hitting at 25% on the year.

PICK: 1 LEMORIAN Going to excuse the pop and stop last time out. That was a G1 at Saratoga and the pace was awfully fast. She has had zero luck in the post draw (tough rail in the debut and widest 9 post last out). Good to see the regular rider back up. Broke 1st both starts. She'll go right to the lead.			PICK: 5 BLING She should have been eliminated after she reared at the gate last out. She broke about 8 lengths behind the field but rallied well for third beaten less than two. Third place finisher two back won the 750k DG Oaks at KD next time out (92 Beyer). Lots of speed to set up a late kick in here.			PICK: 10 C'EST CHEESE 1ster with decent drills at CDT. Worked in company with 2 sibs for this trainer (one for this owner). Both recently debuted at CD sprint MSW company. One of them won at 13-1, other ran 2 nd a photo at 7-1. Sire 20% w/ debut 1 st time 2YO's. The 3 rd dam is the champion \$4M earner Azeri.			
VALUE: 6 KENWICK Very well-bred filly for Godolphin ownership. They also had the dam (raced twice) and the 2 nd dam (G2 winner sprinting on dirt in 2007 at Saratoga). Certainly not for speed figure players but love how she gamely bounced off the rail to surge through to win last out. Prat gets up.			PICK: 4 L J'S EMMA Also came out of the G3 Music City (same as the top pick) in her last start. She ran decently making an early move to the front before tiring a bit after shifting in sharply in the lane. Saez is back up and he rode her in 2 of 3 wins in her career. Another who will like the hot pace up front.			VALUE: 11 EASY STREET First time starter for the very capable Mark Casse. He is about 14% with debut 2YO sprinting on the dirt in MSW here on the Kentucky circuit. Has multiple G1 winning two-year old Dehere in the female line. Gets one of the best riders in the country Gaffalione. Check the betting.

PICK: 9 DOCTOR OSCAR

Despite being a MN-bred this is a real racehorse. He has won 3 of his last 4 (toss the turf try as he's just not bred for that surface). While he crushed MN-bred company in those starts, he was not disgraced in open company in the winter (2nd to Sibelius). Might control the early pace.

VALUE: 3 SIBELIUS

Was 4th beaten just two-lengths in this race last year in a good effort. Beat the top choice at TAM 4 back and he won the Dubai Golden Shaheen next (a \$2M Grade 1 race in Dubai). Thought the Bing Crosby was a key race. The 2nd and 3rd place finishers won stakes in So Cal next out.

PICK: 10 BUCHU

This is when they get serious with a filly from the Galileo line. This is all long distance turf route breeding. Was a stylish winner at CD last out. Runner-up had been 3rd by two at SAR in a MSW in debut. Bumped hard and checked 2 back. Never had much of a chance after that incident.

VALUE: 1 SMOOTH WAVES

Hard to know what she was in with out at KD. She didn't wait around to find out either as she romped by nearly 10 lengths. Winner of the debut is now a 2-time stakes winner. Maker hit the board in 8 of 18 in graded stakes on turf routing for 2YO's. Can be any kind of turf runner.

PICK: 5 V V'S DREAM

Crushed in both wins and in between ran a game 2nd to the likely favorite Brightwork. Female family includes a 1.7M earner (and router) Cupid. Trainer Kenneth McPeck won this race 5 times (all since 2000). Proved going route was within her scope in last. Should move forward today.

VALUE: 6 ALPINE PRINCESS

Brad Cox is always dangerous in spots like this. He is 4 for 12 in G1 routes for 2YO fillies. 2 of the 4 wins came in this race (British Idiom at 7-2 in 2019 and Juju's Map at 5-2 in 2021). He also hit the board in this race in 2020 and 2022. Big time route breeding and goes long for first time.

Excellent effort in the opt clm at KD a few of these come out of. He was 13-1 and closed well despite a wide trip in that last start. 10 post hurt his chances two back but he was only beaten 3 in there. Winner 3 back won 3 straight stakes. Mojica 2 wins, 2 seconds in 4 starts riding this one.

VALUE: 9 CHASING HE CROWN

Only missed the board once in 9 starts. That came first time out, at 1M from the 11 post without blinkers where he was beaten just over a length when 4th. Had to go 7 wide in the last start finishing 2nd as the 4-5 favorite in front of the top choice. Consistent type. Use in the tri's.
