Was 5-1 ML in last and was a huge fav in all the horizontals and won easily. But he was an expensive purchase that dropped into mdn clm and bore out in last. Wins if repeats but there are issues.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 TOIL AND TROUBLE Good run last out when second on the sloppy track at 9-2. Beat the top choice when with Diodoro in the start 3 back. Might have been in too high in the start two back and faded. Don't like that front wraps went on after the claim. Repeat of last puts him in the mix. Takes a drop today which is not uncommon for these connections. He's 5 for 6 in the money at the distance. Eikleberry been up in last 5 starts (resulting in 2 wins over that span).</p> <p>VALUE: 3 I'M AN EIGHT 6YO gelding has carved out a decent career. He is 13 for 23 in the money on the turf. He faced one of the better runners at the meet (Shinny) who has won 5 in a row for Diodoro. 4th two back won in next start. 6th was second next. Might be the controlling speed. A) 3,8 B) 5 C) 1,6,7</p>	<p>3 - CANTERBURY PARK (6:10 CT) 57 MSW 35K, 5.5F DIRT</p> <p>6 OH SO BLEU 3-1 QUINONEZ 7 START SINGING 4-1 WADE 5 SENSE OF FLURRY 5-2 EIKLEBERRY 2 AMARETTO DI AMORE 8-1 FUENTES</p> <p>PICK: 6 OH SO BLEU Debut Mineshaft filly for Mac Robertson. She's been working for quite a while and has a couple of really sharp works (1:00.4 Bg on 8/2). Dam won her debut here in MSW for this ownership almost exactly 8 yrs ago (then went on to two stakes and earn over 274k).</p> <p>VALUE: 7 START SINGING First timer for Tony Rengstorf. The sibling Magician's Holiday won a MSW at this meet by over 7 lengths as a big favorite. Trainer is 4 for 22 with a first timer in MSW. 2nd dam ran third in a graded stakes as a 2YO a few years ago. Quick work on July 18th. Check betting. A) 6,7 B) 2,5 C) 1,3</p>
<p>4 - CANTERBURY PARK (6:40 CT) 54 ALLW 32K, 7.5F TURF</p> <p>5 RUSH HOUR TRAFFIC 3-1 FUENTES 9 PRANKED 5-2 WADE 4 MO CLARE'S 5-1 HAMILTON 7 FALL MOON 9-2 BUTLER</p> <p>PICK: 5 RUSH HOUR TRAFFIC 4YO MN-bred filly has been in the money in 6 stakes races. Was a sharp second to another Mn-bred two back on the turf at 4-1. That was a fast pace there and she was pressing it all the way. Comes in here with a bullet work in 59.2. Will get a good trip today.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 PRANKED Second start for Nevada Litfin. She almost won the Indiana Grand 150k stakes last year at 25-1 for Tom Amoss. She wasn't disgraced in the G2 Edgewood at CD. Good effort when second here. That was a good early move into a fast pace and she tired in the lane. Beat 2 foes in here when 4th to Unleash the Beast in last start. Shuffled start in there and he got off slowly 2 back. Blinkers off here. Will be finishing best today.</p> <p>VALUE: 7 GOT EVEN SMARTER Owner has moved some horses to this trainer back in July. He ran 2nd in two of the last four to start for this trainer (odds of 8-1 and 7-1). Has run 8 times at the 6.5F distance and been in the exacta in 6. Was a good 2nd to the stakes winner Thealligatorhunter. A) 5,7 B) 1,2,3 C) 4</p>	<p>6 - CANTERBURY PARK (7:40 CT) 56 MDN CLM 16K, 7.5F TURF</p> <p>1 WHISKEY PLANK 3-1 WADE 9 OXWOOD 5-1 QUINONEZ 2 SLIGHTLY CRAFTY 8-1 HARR 4 MY VOW IS COURAGE 12-1 FUENTES</p> <p>PICK: 1 WHISKEY PLANK Good effort last time out when off at 32-1 in a MSW on the turf. He pressed the pace from the wide 11 post and ended up with a 3-wide trip. Drew a tough rail post at 5F in his other turf race in MSW at CD 6 starts back. Leading rider stays up today for V Lund.</p> <p>VALUE: 9 OXWOOD Tried MSW company in last and was 32-1 there. He passed a couple of horses late but was not really a danger. Takes the needed drop in class and gets a top rider in Quinonez. Poor start two back but very gamely came on for 3rd at 8-1. Fits at this 16k level. A) 1 B) 2,4,9 C) 3,5,8,10</p>

Only off-the-board run was last out when 4th in a strong opt clm in a really fast time at 7-1. Wide post may be an issue but he should be closing into a quick pace. Quinonez is up.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 TAKE ME UP BRADY Iowa-bred ships up from Prairie Meadows when he was facing high level allowance company there. He has run well on this turf in this past. Rider Harr has been doing well late especially closing on the grass here. That winner was a 30k dropper for one of the top trainers here, Diodoro, and came back and ran 3rd in 10k claiming. This one tried to stay up with him early before tiring. Should be prominent again.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 CAUSEIMCHOCOLATE Mn-bred cuts back in distance after tiring going 1M in two of the last three starts. The sprint in between was very good when second at 11-1. He faced much better in the first four starts including Mn-bred's in stakes twice. Will stalk from the inside post in here.</p> <p>A) 2,4 B) 1,3,6,8 C) 5,7</p>	<p>9 - CANTERBURY PARK (9:10 CT) 75 MDN 19K, 250Y QH</p> <p>7 LADY CAPO 9-5 MARTINEZ 2 FIND A RIDER 5-2 GOODWIN 1 CATCH THE DRAMA 8-1 VEGA 4 QUEEN OF DA NORT 5-1 VALENZUELA</p> <p>PICK: 7 LADY CAPO Fired in all 3 starts this year. Those 3 starts are first 3 for Ed Ross Hardy with this filly. Ducked out at the start in last as the even money favorite and it was a difference in her winning. Beaten by the favorite 2 back who came back to run 2nd in allw for Olmstead.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 CATCH THE DRAMA Has some races that put her in the mix in here. She was third three back at 13-1. Veered out two back in a common race in the mud at 5-1. Made a mess last out at the break and never got going in there. Needs to break better from the rail. <p>10 - CANTERBURY PARK (9:40 CT) 86 OPT CLM 18K, 350Y QH</p> <p>3 CHANGE N GEARS 8-5 ESCOBEDO 6 CHICKSFABULOUSCORONA 3-1 PACKER 1 HAUTE WAGON 8-1 HARR 2 IM CHASIN WAGONS 4-1 ESTRADA</p> <p>PICK: 3 CHANGE N GEARS 3YO gelding in the money 8 straight after a 5th in the debut here 14 months ago. Last two were on muddy tracks. Winner 2,3 back is a stablemate who is 3 for 3 at the meet. Last win came at tougher RP circuit 4 back at 20-1. Seems 350 yards is the ideal distance.</p> <p>VALUE: 1 HAUTE WAGON This is an all-or-nothing proposition. He's had awful starts in 7 straight races and possibly just can't get out of the gate anymore. Last time he broke well he was third at 6-1 in a stakes here a year ago.
