Her form has been rock solid once she was claimed 8 starts back from Santa Anita. Trainer Russell is a super trainer who can keep them going in the right direction. Handled no Lasix in the last two. Subpar performance for Russell came on the grass 5 starts ago. Not a very strong field for this 150,000 stakes.

VALUE: 8 SPIKED

6 for 8 in the money. One of her off-the-board starts came on a sloppy track. The other was a decent 4th in a full field of 12. Added blinkers 4 back and she's won twice with them (although was DQ'd out of the win in one of them). Pace could be a bit quirky. None of these really wants to be in front. She might send.

Always have to worry about a G1 runner making the return to start the next year. Ward had two last out G1 runners return in a dirt sprint. He won one and was a close third in the other. Should get a very fast pace to set up his late run. Gaffalione rode him in 4 of 5 career wins. Love the slow works. It's a big tipoff.

VALUE: 6 LITTLE VIC

This horse is talented but also a bleeder. He was in a good spot 4 back but backed up in that G1. He bled in that race and laid off. Last 3 weren't good so he was laid off again. Beat the top choice in the Grade 3 Tom Fool on a muddy track. Reportedly on edge in the Jan 14th work. Will be finishing very well in here.

Gets speed from the female line which has mostly sprinters in the pedigree (dam was a G1 winner on dirt at 7F). Sire gets a lot of very long distance types. The :44.3 half in the Iroquois was the fastest 4F half time of that day (including a 300k sprint won by G1 type Bango). Really love the works leading into this.

VALUE: 7 COPPER TAX

This is a case of letting the horse take you to where he belongs. Started out in maiden claiming and in restricted allowance at Delaware. He won 5 straight last year before a 6th in the Remsen. That G2 might turn out to be strong. 3rd won a 150k stakes next. 7th was 2nd in the G3 Holy Bull. 9th was 2nd in the Swale.

Fits in here.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 APROPOS Hard to know what this 4YO will do in her first grass start. She showed some promise early on but beat just 9 runners in the 3 starts since her maiden win. This one has only run poorly once and that came in the very tough G1 Hopeful. He really was unchallenged in 2 stakes here since shipping in from KEE. Asmussen is 20 for 50 (40%) with 37 in the money (74%) when in a dirt sprint stakes, 3YO only and off at 2-1 or less.</p> <p>VALUE: 3 GOOGOL JOKE Was off slow in the Renaissance won by the top pick last time out. He gathered himself, ended up with a wide trip and was passing runners in the lane for a third place finish at 17-1. Rider got to know him out of that start and is back here. Sharp 4F move on this surface. Bred to sprint. Almost pulled off a 40-1 puzzler in the G2 at KD. Looking for a pace meltdown vs. these.</p> <p>VALUE: 2 COPPOLA Pretty decent effort in the common stakes here last time out. This one did some dirty work pressing the fast early pace. He didn't completely give in when 4th by just over length. Really like the style he deployed in the CD win 9 back when he earned a 101 fig. But he's been working on the dirt and certainly has a bit of class to him out of those turf starts. Troubled trip in the G2 last out. Deep closer isn't catching all that strong a field for this level. Will be motoring home.</p> <p>VALUE: 6 CRYPTO RIDE He's been off a long time and now moves to a new barn (Leonard Powell). Clockers indicate the works coming into this race are sharp. Has had just three poor starts. Two were on the grass and once in last where something went wrong that prompted such a long layoff. She won over \$2M. She was 2nd in the 2012 BC F&M Turf and won multiple Grade 1's on the turf. Nice win at KD in his second career start and first on the grass. Did little in the Pilgrim and most recent start was off the turf. Blinkers off, Lasix on.</p> <p>VALUE: 10 IN A JAM Always have to pay attention to where Irad Ortiz is. He looks like he landed on the controlling speed to the outside. Both starts going long were good. Was nosed out two back from the 11 post in an unlucky defeat. Got a bit more comfortable pace to set last out and kicked on for the win.
