PICK: 4 TRUE LEGEND Trainer George Weaver is 9 for 31 (29%) with 19 in the money (61%) with a huge \$3.55 ROI and an average win of 5-1 odds with 2YO debut sprinting on the turf in MSW. The second dam was placed in graded turf stakes. Weaver always works slow. Rider 24% for him.
VALUE: 9 MURSAL Less fancied of the two in the race for Linda Rice as this one comes in with 4 straight bad efforts after a win for 35k claiming. But despite the poor form, Rice dipped in and took her for 12k last time out. Eased in that race but has had 7 weeks. Feels like she'll run. PICK: 10 CAROLANNIE The top two morning line favorites come out of the same MSW at Ellis Park. Notice this one was 7-2 (but probably due to Brad Cox as much as anything). She didn't have a great trip but was making up ground in the late stages. A better result with a better break.
