Off dead last in the debut and was climbing early on. Another poo start second out. Goes from turf to dirt, drops into claiming, Lasix is added for the first time, adds blinkers and is a first time gelding. Love the 47.1 drill on the SA dirt just 6 days ago. 55k purchase will be better.

One of three in the race for Carla Gaines and one of three in the race that exists the strong 5F MSW at DMR. The two runners who've come back (1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>) both won. Have to note that Hernandez is back. Another who has a strong worktab coming into this. Looks well-meant.

#### **VALUE: 3 THANK YOU HONEY**

We really do not know if this one can run. We do know the debut isn't an indicator. He went out in sub:22 and:46.1 for a mile on this turf and that is just too fast. The top 3 finishers all came from well back. Sire won nearly \$2M on the turf. Well-spaced worktab here for Gaines.

#### **VALUE: 4 STRANGE ADDICTION**

Interesting that she's only started in a route twice. She was favored in the first route but a wide draw cost her. She won the other time in a similar kind of race at GG. Did not have a good trip last out from the rail. Dettori sticks with her. Bred more for route then for sprint.

#### VALUE: 5 IRISH WHINE

11 of the last 12 horses that trainer Stute has started hit the board. This 5YO mare has won 5 of her last 6 starts on the dirt. Stute is just 1 for 8 off the claim on the dirt but 7 of the 8 ran in the money. Form is very good and she likes to win. Gets does get test for class in this one.

#### **VALUE: 4 SPEED GRAZY**

He's hit the board in 16 of 27 starts although many of those where on synthetic. Has won 2 times out of 7 starts on the dirt. Tried to close last out on a speed favoring LRC track and he did so with a wide trip. Just 2<sup>nd</sup> start for Glatt today. Dettori up. Will be finishing best of all.

Was RNA (Reserve Not Attained) at the 2022 Cal sale for 38k so he stays with this breeder George Krikorian. This owner had 3 firsters in a MSW debut for Sadler, all were by the same sire Mr. Big. He won twice and was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the other. All had a very fast drill prior to the race.
