A CLOSER LOOK

Country Coast

Hasn't been able to meet the cameraman since leaving California and his late-running style has put him at the mercy of the pace; Amoss is having a fine meet and he adds blinkers in an attempt to sharpen the early speed; ran into a good bunch last time (Cat's At Home recently Beyered 97 in an AN3X score and Uncle Abbie took AN2X foos with a 99 'fig'), but don't like the way he drifted late; most recent drill was 2/5's faster than stable star Heritage Of Gold, and this guy may be closer to the pace from the rail; solid colt loses Sellers to Unshaded and may lack the class to compete at the very top level.

Curule

Godolphin representative has raced in good form since the Belmont debacle and picked up the pieces in the Jim Dandy with the aid of a torrid pace battle; while outside closers fared well that day, Curule raced inside until the quarter pole before angling out; doesn't have to deal with Graeme Hall here and the word is he'll be closer to the early splits; draws well and should be right up on the pace, perhaps nearest to Albert The Great; might be able to attain 1st run and is bred to handle 10 furlongs; dangerous at a price.

Commendable

Belmont hero has yet to prove that his classic win was nothing more than a fluke; found trouble early in both his subsequent starts, but wasn't able to muster a strong stretch rally; Lukas must always be feared in the biggies, but he is slumping terribly this meet; wonder if Patient Pat will gun early in an attempt to duplicate the last win, but Albert The Great would likely keep him company; probably will sit 2-5 lengths off the lead, but must prove that he can pass horses late; shaky.

Milwaukee Brew

Inside speed was golden on Haskell day, so it's safe to say that Brew ran against a half a bias as he saved ground at the back of the pack; uncorked a strong late rally and his last 3 Beyer figures are exceptional; handled the previously unbeaten Brave Quest at Thistledown and hasn't been off the board since his debut try; powerful Stronach barn attracts Bailey and the masterful rider should have this colt within striking range from 5-7 lengths off the lead; late-bloomer looks to have upside potential and should be respected as a late threat; factor.

Postponed

These connections won last year's renewal of the Midsummer Derby with Lemon Drop Kid, and Postponed made a gaudy, but premature middle move in the Jim Dandy; bears several similarities to Unshaded (both received excellent preps races, both race today in their 2nd start off a layoff, and both have yet to Beyer 100) although this guy has better tactical speed; Scotty at first was wavering on whether to run here and Unshaded has bested him in their last 2 meetings; expecting improvement from closer up, but leaning elsewhere for the winner.

The Jim Dandy looks like a perfect prep as the gelded son of Unbridled was forced to wait for running room at the quarter pole while running on the deeper inside (outside closers did best that day); add the fact that he'll be going 2nd off the layoff in here with a couple of sharp 5 furlong drills showing and he owns the look of a bona fide contender; on the negative side, he has been the beaten chalk in 2 of his last 3 races, and has not gained late ground since front wraps were added; Nafzger is eating a donut this meet and his closer may not receive rapid early fractions to rally into; yet to reach the 100 Beyer plateau and his major competitors have hit the 110's; very capable, but taking a stand against.

Dixie Union

Mandella always thought highly of this son of Dixieland Band and his Haskell win was nothing short of fantastic; got into traffic trouble early and was shuffled back before commencing a wide rally over a surface that favored inside speed; shows a sharp drill and his excellent tactical speed should suit him beautifully; think he'll be stalking Albert The Great from close range and should be a menacing presence at the quarter pole; trip poses a question mark for this logical contender, but he should be making major noise nonetheless.

Impeachment

Although this Pletcher trainee is still eligible for a N2L race, he had a busy spring, finishing 3rd in the 1st 2 legs of the Triple Crown before tailing off in the paceless Belmont; willing to toss the Haskell as he raced against a severe speed/rail bias in his 1st start back from a lay-off; most recent drill went in the same time as barnmate Canfield (solid allowance runner who is entered on the undercard); plodder figures to be lagging far behind early and needs quick splits to setup his kick; don't think the race flow will be that generous and a minor award seems most likely.

Albert The Great

Zito wasn't happy with the Jim Dandy trip as Migliore went on a kamikaze mission from the far outside post; never attained the same breather he received in the Dwyer and folded poorly while racing against the grain (outside closers benefitted best that day); switches to Chavez, but is faced with another poor post and a similar dilemma...to send or not to send?; very interesting that the blinkers are removed as Albert has yet to win without the hood; still think he has the best early speed of this crew and should be able to make the top with the longer run into the turn; working well and was sparkling when reeling off 4 in a row earlier this year; talented speedster is a viable gate-to-wire threat and should be accorded an excellent chance.
