

**NINTH RACE**  
**Belmont**  
**JUNE 6, 1998**

**1½ MILES. (2.24) 130th Running of THE BELMONT. Grade I. Purse \$1,000,000 (plus up to \$72,000 NYSBFOA). 3-year-olds. By subscription of \$600 to accompany the nomination if made on or before January 17, or \$6,000 if made on or before March 28, \$10,000 to pass the entry box, \$10,000 to start. At any time prior to the closing time of entries, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$100,000 to the New York Racing Association Inc. All supplementary fees will be included in the purse distribution. Horses nominated by payment of a supplementary fee (supplemental nominees) will not be allowed to enter if the maximum number of starters has otherwise been reached prior to the time of closing. All entrants, supplemental or otherwise, will be required to pay entry and starting fees. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: Colts and geldings, 126 lbs. Fillies, 121 lbs. Starters to be named at the closing time of entries. The Belmont field will be limited to sixteen (16) starters. In the event that more than 16 entries pass through the entry box at the closing, the starters will be determined at the closing with 50% of the field (8 starters) given preference by accumulating the highest earnings in Graded Stakes (lifetime), including all money paid for performance in such Grades Stakes. The next five (5) starters (approximate 30%) will be determined by accumulating the highest earnings (lifetime) in all races except restricted races (i.e. any stake containing eligibility conditions other than sex and age). The remaining three starters (approximate 20%) shall be determined by accumulating the highest earnings (lifetime) in all races. Should this preference produce any ties, the additional starter(s) shall be determined by lot. If the rules described result in the exclusion of any horse, the \$10,000 entry fee will be refunded to the owner of said horse. The winning owner will be presented with the August Belmont Memorial Cup, to be retained for one year, as well as a trophy for permanent possession and trophies to the winning trainer and jockey. Closed Thursday, June 4, with 384 early nominations and 6 late nominations.**

VICTORY GALLOP bumped with YARROW BRAE at the start, raced far back for six furlongs, worked his way forward while four wide on the turn, split rivals entering the stretch, closed the gap in midstretch then finished determinedly to wear down REAL QUIET in the final strides. REAL QUIET settled in the middle of the pack for five furlongs, moved up rapidly while four wide on the far turn, surged to the front nearing the quarter pole, opened a wide gap in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into midstretch, drifted out under left hand whipping, bumping twice with the winner in deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. THOMAS JO reserved for six furlongs, edged closer while four wide on the turn then finished willingly in the middle of the track to gain a share. PARADE GROUND outrun for six furlongs, checked in traffic while lacking room on the turn then improved his position with a mild late rally. RAFFIE'S MAJESTY unhurried early, launched a rally leaving the far turn, steadily gained along the inside to reach contention at the quarter pole then flattened out a bit in the lane. CHILITO sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace along the inside to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. GRAND SLAM prompted the pace outside CHILITO for nearly a mile and tired from his early efforts. CLASSIC CAT never reached contention. LIMIT OUT up close early with the saddle slipping on the first turn, raced within striking distance along the inside to the far turn then lacked a further response. YARROW BRAE raced just off the pace while three wide for six furlongs and gave way on the turn. BASIC TRAINEE was outrun after breaking slowly. Following a stewards inquiry into the stretch run, there was no change in the order of finish.
