Turf-on-turf pedigree. Sib Pletcher-trained turf miler. His debut was good as the lone closer into a slow, wire-to-wire pace (top 5 early all finished top 6). Other turf races that day posted faster half-mile times. Pletcher 4-for-7 (57%) with second-time MSW runners going long on turf with Irad Ortiz for Repole. French-bred just needs to break quicker.

VALUE: 11 BRAT PACK

Very well-bred filly for Graham Motion. Drew a tough inside post in her debut and made it harder by breaking slowly. Slow fractions favored those on or near the pace, yet she still closed for second, alongside another Motion runner who was third. With a better break, a more aggressive ride could put her on the lead. There appears to be some talent.

This one goes from two riders that are a combined 2 for 35 at the meet to the Eclipse Award winning rider in Irad Ortiz. That is a massive change. He's been pressing 45.1 and 46 second half-mile times. That should put him right on the lead with these. Lost the irons two back and that cost him a better finish. Awfully tough to get by Irad Ortiz in the lane.

VALUE: 6 DOMINICAN THUNDER

Moved from a trainer who was just 7 for 101 on the season to a 17% outfit before the start two back. This will be his first try on the dirt for the new connections. Faced better in the starts previously while in New York. Once went for 100k at a sale in 2023. Never been on the board in 12 races so far which will ensure a good price. Must use in the super.

Blinkers removed in the last start when he was 4th in an 8k similar spot. He ended up with a wide trip which cost him some ground on the turn. Winner two back came back to win an opt clm by 5 lengths at 5-2 at Tampa. He's 4 for 6 at the distance and best races have come at GP. Big rider add to Zayas. Trainer just 26 starters and won with his last one.

VALUE: 1 DREAMS OF MYFATHER

He won by 7 lengths in July to clear the non-winners of two lifetime condition. Since then, he's run on dirt four times. In 3 of those 4 races, he was off poorly (and in one of those races he eased). The race he broke well was two back when he missed by a neck. Gets a 10 pound weight allowance with this rider. If he breaks he'll get a good trip.

4 – GULFSTREAM PARK (1:50 ET) MAIDEN CLAIMING 17K, 1M 70 SYNTHETIC 1 WELL SHAKEN 6-5 2 DIVINE BLUE 6-1 6 LUCKY BERRY 5-2 7 SWEET RUBY 8-1 PICK: 1 WELL SHAKEN Both of her starts on synthetic came for 35k (twice the tag price of today). She was beaten about 5-lengths in each of those starts in very good efforts in this context. Had much trouble in the start two back. A runner bolted early in the race and carried her out 7 or 8 deep losing a lot of ground in the first furlong. Irad Ortiz is up. Clearly the one to beat. VALUE: 2 DIVINE BLUE She's had a difficult time early in her races. She was rank 2 and 3 back and lost a lot of ground. Connections wanted to overcome that so they let her run off last time and she opened up a huge lead in fast fractions before tiring. Think they'll ease her back just a bit. She's had plenty of starts to work it out. Certainly fits with these and at a decent price. The trainer, Antonacci, has 5 either first or second from 5 starts at the meet. 4 of the 5 were shippers from New York. Also, 4 of the 5 were for this ownership. 4 th , 5 th , 6 th from the second start (at SAR) all won back. 6 th has since won the G3 Pebbles at AQU on the turf. Lone start here (debut) he stumbled out of the gate. VALUE: 4 THE DOVE RULES She's run 6 times on the turf at this distance. She has not won yet but has been on the board 3 times (all here at GP). She outran her odds when second from dead-last in the middle of the race last time out. Might have won if not for some traffic on the far turn that forced her to wait. Gets a big rider addition in Gaffalione. Will be finishing fastest late. A) 5 B) 4,6,7,8 C) 1,2 D) 3	6 – GULFSTREAM PARK (2:50 ET) CLAIMING 8K, 5.5F DIRT 4 IMAPEPPA 5-1 7 EL GUTY 5-2 5 FEELING MACHO 6-1 1 DOGWOOD CROSSING 10-1 PICK: 4 IMAPEPPA With a 4% trainer until 4 back and has since hit the board in all 4. Post draws haven't helped—twice on the rail and twice posted wide. The trainer is 4-for-24 first off the claim (8 in the money), including 3-for-5 when off under 6-1. Adds an apprentice rider here and drops 11 pounds from last out. Slow works might be to ward off interest in a claim. VALUE: 5 FEELING MACHO Looks like the main speed in the race. Was about 2 behind #7 El Guty in the last start when for Steve Klesaris. Claimed out of that race by a trainer who is 1 for 31. The good news is that 1 win came in his last start. He's had one claim (also from a 22% trainer) and he ran 2nd first time off that claim for the same 8k tag earlier this year. Will need to be caught. A) 4,7 B) 1,5 C) 2,3,6 D)
7 – GULFSTREAM PARK (3:20 ET) CLAIMING 17K, 1M 70 SYNTHETIC 5 AMERICAN SPEED 9-2 4 AMERICAN FARMER 7-2 1 MAKTUB 15-1 7 BAYTOWN PARFAIT 2-1 PICK: 5 AMERICAN SPEED 5YO gets into this race as a non-winner since last Nov. He was privately purchased after the start in Jan when he was DQ'd for the 2nd race in a row due to a medication issue from the prior outfit. Ran respectably against higher lately. This is a serious class drop. Has a win on the GP synthetic track. Winner of last returned to win at same level (89 fig). VALUE: 4 AMERICAN FARMER Hard to know what to make of this one. They claimed him from a 32k claimer at Del Mar in Aug 2024 and now, after a layoff of a year and a half, he's dropped in for 17k. Clearly has issues. But this trainer is 2 for 6 (33%) with 4 in the top two finishers (66%) first off the claim for this owner. Won 7 times on the synthetic at Golden Gate. Check for betting. A) 4,5 B) 1,7,8 C) 2,6 D) 3	8 – GULFSTREAM PARK (3:50 ET) OPTIONAL CLAIMING 58K, 6F DIRT 3 PURE CLASS 7-2 1 AMERICAN MONARCH 5-2 4 SOUPER QUEST 2-1 6 JACK'S PROMISE 10-1 PICK: 3 PURE CLASS Trainer David Fawkes has won 5 of 15 starts at the meet so far. He has won 43% in the last 4 months at GP when he's running one who goes off at 4-1 or less. He beat similar 2 back at 7F. Faced a tough group at Tampa. The third place finisher won a starter allw at OP for Larry Rivelli and has won 428k in his career. Attracts a top rider Gaffalione here. VALUE: 6 JACK'S PROMISE Not really sure what happened in the last start but he has been known to just toss in clunkers (see 5, 6 back when he basically eased). Dale Romans colt won 2 of his last 3 races and was barely beaten in the other before last. Thinking the last start was an anomaly otherwise he'd be in for the tag today. Zipped in the 12/16 work at 4F. Will be finishing. She makes her first start for the new connections in here. Won the G2 Glens Falls for the previous connections in the start 3 back. She did so by nearly 9 lengths which is not a thing you normally see in a turf graded stakes. Could jump up for Brad Cox and Irad Ortiz. Never off the board at GP. VALUE: 5 NO SHOW SAMMY JO It could be argued that she doesn't want anything but firm turf. She flopped three back on the yielding turf but starts around that were very good. Shuffled back and lost ground in the last start and then just couldn't close the gap when the winner went so slow on the front end. She still ran big to grab 2nd.
