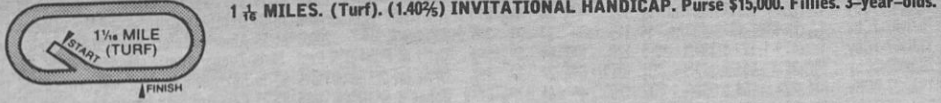

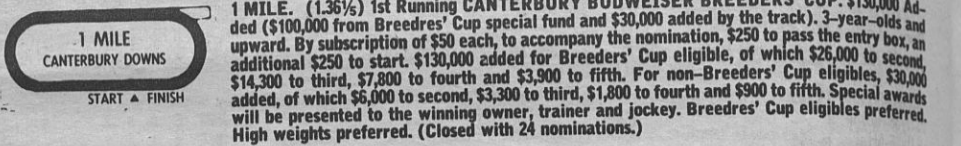

Questions & Answers

"How much difference is there, physically, between a male horse and female horse? Is the difference in strength as great, for example, as between a man and a woman?"

"There is relatively little difference in strength between male and female horses," says Dr. Charles Hagyard, dean of American veterinarians. "All species vary from individual to individual, of course, but I think that the scale of weight gives us a good clue to this question. The scale, developed over the years, gives the fillies an allowance of five pounds before September 1 and three pounds thereafter. Theoretically this modest difference will bring the males and females together. The difference is greater among humans."

"How closely are workouts related to performance?"

An interesting question and a difficult one to answer because there are so many different types of workouts. Good trainers tailor their workouts to the situation. The late Sunny Jim Fitzsimmons, for example, was preparing Nashua for the Widener Handicap of 1956 without a prep race. The strapping horse hadn't started in about four months, so a week prior to the race, Mr. Fitz vanned him to Tropical Park and worked him a mile and a quarter in 2:01 3/5. He knew the horse needed that kind of work to be ready for as demanding a test as the Widener, and he knew Nashua was rugged enough to take it. His thinking was sound, for Nashua won.

Now let's switch to Derby Week, 1931, at Churchill Downs. The late James Rowe Jr. breezed Twenty Grand a mile in 1:45, and his colleagues were aghast. Something is wrong with the colt, was the consensus opinion. But Twenty Grand won the Derby by four lengths. Rowe knew that his horse, having won the Wood Memorial, didn't need any more than that to be at his best. Similarly, Chateaugay won the Derby of 1963 off a mile in 1:47 because Jimmy Conway knew his horse and had the courage of his convictions.

Thus it can be said the relationship between workouts and performance is complex, based on situation and individual.

"If a horse appears in the paddock wearing bandages, should this affect my selection if I have handicapped the horse to win?"

"In most cases, if I liked a horse, it would not affect my opinion to see that horse appear in the paddock wearing bandages," comments Hall of Fame trainer Woody Stephens. "In the better races, many trainers employ racing bandages to protect their horses. Perhaps the horse has been hitting himself, or is tender from a previous injury. In the cheaper races, bandages can be used to arouse suspicion of injury and lessen the danger that the horse will be claimed. Can improper bandaging cause injury? Yes, but experienced racing men are aware of this and take care to see that the bandages are put on correctly."

Types of Racing Plates

FRONT—The front or plain horseshoe is a standard plate fashioned with a "toe" and used on a fast or dry track.

OUTER RIM FRONT—A variety of the front shoe. It has a "grab" around the outer rim to keep a horse standing level and to reduce hoof shock. It can be used on either the turf or the dirt.

JAR CALK—A shoe used on the front hooves for muddy and sloppy tracks.

MUD CALK—A plate with a "toe" and a sharp "sticker" on the heel, which gives a horse a better grip or tread on a muddy track.

BLOCK HEEL—A shoe constructed with raised blocks behind and used to prevent horses from running down on their heels and to prevent slipping.

INNER RIM FRONT and INNER RIM BLOCK HEEL—Used to keep a horse standing level at all times, and are excellent plates on the grass.

BLOCK HEEL STICKER—A plate that prevents a horse from running down and at the same time incorporates the features of the Mud Calk.

Two other types of plates, which are not used frequently, follow:

BAR—A shoe with a bar across the heel with or without "stickers" and used primarily for the protection of quarter cracks.

RAISED BAR—Shoes equipped with raised bar or "trailer" to provide cushion for horses who ordinarily run down badly on their heels or fetlocks.

a handicapper's Questions & Answers the expert By JOE HIRSCH. "What percentage of jockeys riding today are considered good gate boys?" "I think it's more to the point to say that only a small percentage of riders today are poor gate boys," comments John L. Rotz, a steward at New York tracks and a former rider with more than 2,900 winners to his credit in 24 seasons as a jockey. "The start of a race is very important because of the large number of six and seven-furlong events carded at American tracks. However, it is more often the horse and not the rider who may be responsible for a bad start. Perhaps the horse is standing poorly, or hasn't had sufficient schooling at the gate."

"What is the major difference in the feeding of horses on the day of a race, as opposed to their diet on a day when they don't race?" "The principal is the same as it is with humans," says trainer J. J. Toner. "When you are getting ready to participate in strenuous activity, you don't eat a heavy meal. We treat every horse as an individual and their diets may vary, but generally speaking, we cut back the grain we feed to fillies and give them just a little hay on the day of a race so that they have something to nibble on and don't get nervous. For colts on the day of a race, we generally withdraw their hay and give them a little grain, at the normal feeding times of 4 a.m. and 10 a.m. Horses will fill up very easily if you don't watch them carefully." "I recently read a story that said a horse was 'over at the knee.' Exactly what does this mean?" The perfectly conformed horse, when viewed from the side, presents a perpendicular line from the shoulder to the ankle. A horse said to be "over at the knee" is one whose lower leg, below the knee, angles slightly backward. Unless this is accompanied by weakness, it is not very significant, in the opinion of many horsemen. A number of good horses were "over at the knee."
