The 2nd place finisher has won 648k in his 29-race career and came back out of that race to run 2nd in an opt clm. 5th in that race won next out in opt clm at Sam Houston at 2-1 (86 Beyer) for Asmussen. Clear the prior connections were ready to move on. He's run quite well for this trainer (Peitz) who wins a fair amount at OP when long odds.
