Blinkers come back on for this one. He first had them in the start 5 back when he was beaten just a half-length at this same distance. Been sluggish early in the last two so adds blinkers and a good gate rider in Tyler Baze. Fits with these.

Trainer McCarthy is 5 for 13 (38%) w/ 8 in the money (62%) and a \$4.64 ROI with a 1<sup>st</sup> timer in MSW sprinting on the dirt at 7-1 odds or less. Has a sibling that won by 13-lengths in her debut. Decent SLR drills for this 4YO filly. Check betting.
