**Pick: 7 Kentucky Cool**

Last 3 starts were pretty bad so he was sent to the shelf for 7 months. He comes back at a much higher level than he was at here last year off the layoff. Notice McKee was up for two blowout wins here. Should grab a great early spot with his route speed. Check tote.

**Value: 9 Akami**

Pretty consistent for this level. He was very close in all 3 starts over this surface and all were at this same 16k level. New rider gets up today (Talamo) who has been cold at the meet. Can stalk or close which gives Talamo options. Pace plays a big part for him today.

**Pick: 10 Lou's Legacy**

Front wraps were removed when he ran off the layoff 3 back. 2 of the 3 races since the return are very good which says he's better now than as a 2YO. Winner 3 back looks like a serious runner for Bill Mott (2 for 2, both wins by daylight). Will be close early in here.

**Value: 4 Contemplation**

Drew a difficult inside post in the debut at 6F. He ran evenly despite lagging a bit early on. Adds ground for which he's bred (dam is full sib to the 2018 Gotham winner, Enticed. 2<sup>nd</sup> dam, It's Tricky, was a 3-time G1 winner on dirt for \$1.6M. Serious work in March 23.

**Pick: 1 Blue Furnace**

Trainer Cherie DeVaux is 7 for 18 (39%) with 13 in the money (72%) and a healthy \$3.06 ROI when she brings a MSW runner back off a similar layoff. It's pretty safe to assume he bled last out at under 4-1 when he eased in. Gets first Lasix. A sharp worktab for this.

**Value: 3 Accident**

These are the kind of horses bettors love to hate. He's run 26 times without a win. He's picked up checks in 4 stakes along the way and has earnings near 200k. It could be he just likes to run with horses and not actually pass them. Drew bad posts in 4 of the last 5.

She's been sensational on this polytrack at Turfway Park. Took money in the debut but did nothing last August. Since her comeback she's been unbeatable. The maiden win was a key race. Runner-up was beaten just one in the G3 Fla Oaks. Is a sib to a 300k earner.

**Value: 6 Pipit**

Couldn't really handle the top pick last time out in the Valdale but if that winner is what we expect her to be this one could chunk up for the runner-up spot. Stakes placed in the start two back which was with the blinkers coming off. Only poor start was going a route.

**Value: 3 Colbaloaf**

There is just one way to go with this one and that is to open up early. It all depends what the other riders do. If they allow him to coast comfortably assuming he tires, he may not. Reclaim by these connections last out. May just be in great form. Gets a class test here.

The last 4 Paulo Lobo sent out in debut in a maiden claimer at TP (all last Dec) ran well. Two of them won (and one of those winners was at the 30k level) and another was 2<sup>nd</sup> by a head. Works are rather typical for a debut Lobo (slow). His live runners usually are bet.

**Value: 1 Bolt On the Rocks**

She was one of two runners in the debut for this trainer, Mick Ruis. She got away in a bit of a tangle and lagged far back before she moved on the turn and passed runners late in the lane. Takes a slight drop for this. Gets a better post. Eligible to improve in 2<sup>nd</sup> start.
