

ON THIS DATE (1986) – STAFF RIOT was 3rd to Lost Code and Proudest Duke in the 1987 St. Paul Derby at long odds. On August 31, 1986, he won the \$189,000 Canterbury Juvenile Stakes at 20-1 beating 13 rivals including Texas Trio and Dakota Slew. He won three stakes at CBY in two years for Kathy Hutchinson and would win \$319,215 in a 23 race career.
