Female family includes \$900k winning sibs Ginger Brew and Bourbon Bay. Both were best going well beyond one mile. Earned a 91 Beyer Speed Figure in the Tremont 3 back and then had some traffic issues in the next two. Adds blinkers for this and has a bullet drill at SAR since.
