ALYSHEBA, reserved while being outrun into the backstretch, was carefully handled while moving up behind BET TWICE approaching the far turn, moved fast from the outside when clear nearing the stretch and outfinished BET TWICE under brisk lefthanded urging. BET TWICE, allowed to follow the leaders while racing well out in the track, moved to the fore from the outside approaching the stretch and held on stubbornly in a long drive. CRYPTOCLEARANCE, outrun early, moved up inside approaching the end of the backstretch, came out between horses to continue his rally nearing the stretch, moved back to the inside for the drive but wasn't able to gain on the leaders. GULCH, in hand early, moved around horses to loom a threat approaching the stretch but weakened during the drive. AVIES COPY passed tired horses while racing very wide. PHANTOM JET moved within striking distance approaching the stretch but lacked a further response. LOOKINFORTHEBIGONE raced outside HARRIMAN while vying for the lead, remained prominent to the stretch and tired badly. NO MORE FLOWERS, close up for six furlongs, tired badly. HARRIMAN raced well out in the track while showing speed to the far turn and stopped suddenly.
