ON THIS DATE (1991) – **WHO DOCTOR WHO** was one of the most popular horses to ever run at Canterbury. The Nebraska-bred started his career in 1985 in NE. He is one of 13 horses in the Canterbury Hall of Fame. On July 27, 1991, Who Doctor Who won for the final time, a \$20,000 Handicap at Ak-Sar-Ben. His 33 career wins ranks #96 of most by any horse.
