RACHEL ALEXANDRA relaxed under a long hold to track GABBY'S GOLDEN GAL after allowing that one to take the early lead, moved up outside that one leaving the backstretch on her own courage to challenge, took over approaching the stretch and rapidly drew off in the stretch without being asked at any time to pick up her pace. STONE LEGACY outrun along the inside, saved ground on the second turn and improved her position while never a threat to the winner. FLYING SPUR within striking distance three wide, failed to respond on the second turn and gave way in the drive. BE FAIR forwardly placed from the start, raced in the two path on the second turn and faded in the stretch. NAN outrun to the stretch, could not menace. GABBY'S GOLDEN GAL set a solid pace for six furlongs, attempted to go with the winner with three furlongs to go, could not keep pace late on the second turn and gave way in the drive. TWEETER reserved off the rail, stopped.
