Value to winner \$127,800, second \$25,000 third \$12,500, fourth \$5,000. Closed February 15, 1970 with 193 nominations. Mutuel pool \$2,383,912.

Dust Commander soundly bumped at start to be hard held early, commenced to advance along inside after a half mile, continued to save ground to final bend where he was forced to come out between horses to launch his rally, remained slightly wide into stretch and responding to pressure was up leaving furlong marker and drew well clear under intermittent urging. My Dad George slow to begin and unhurried for three-quarters, commenced to advance from between horses on leaving backstretch, cut back to inside on final bend to loom boldly in upper stretch but could not sustain his bid. High Echelon badly outrun for a mile came to extreme outside to circle his field entering stretch and finished boldly. Naskra in hand while being outrun launched a bid from between horses on second turn to loom menacingly a furlong away but could not sustain his rally. Silent Screen soundly bumped and knocked off stride soon after start, was forced to be sent along to remain in contention, continued along outside to take command boldly on final bend, drew off in upper stretch only to falter when subjected to extreme pressure. Admiral's Shield found his best stride too late. Corn Off The Cob in hand early, moved up strongly to loom a contender on final bend but had little left when real test came. Personality failed to enter contention. Native Royalty was never a factor. Robin's Bug stopped badly after showing good speed for three-quarters. Terlago dropped back steadily. George Lewis gave way suddenly after prompting the issue of top of stretch. Rancho Lejos broke alertly to swerve to inside into horses, ducked out abruptly while being straightened into Silent Screen, continued on the lead to midway of second turn where he collapsed suddenly. Holy Land clipped horses heels while in close quarters midway of second turn and fell.
