Sib to Double Thunder, 2<sup>nd</sup> in the '21 G1 Breeders' Futurity. Caught a major key race two back. 2<sup>nd</sup> won a FG MSW and then the 100k Gun Runner in next two starts. 4<sup>th</sup> won a FG MSW next (81 Beyer). 6<sup>th</sup> won a MSW and was 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Gun Runner. Even 8<sup>th</sup> won a MSW at CD at 24-1 next out. Adds the blinkers and stretches out. He will be forwardly placed.

VALUE: 1 BOURBONKOMA

Must look at the debut as little more than a prep to get him started in his career. The pedigree leans route and that CD debut was sprinting. In addition, a very low percentage rider was up and this is a huge change to Luis Saez. Didn't help matters with a troubled start and wide trip. Draws the 1 post today and an aggressive gate rider. Better trip here.

Ken McPeek isn't overly proficient with first time starters. So when they run big, as this one did, you can expect that they will improve in the second start. It's not easy to win at Turfway Park routing in the debut from the 8 post while closing into a speed favoring track but this one was just a nose from winning. He's just a 12k purchase. Nice local drill.

VALUE: 3 PALMER BEACH

He went off at nearly 70-1 in the debut here sprinting in a pretty solid MSW. He was slow early but passed some late in the race to split the field. Most of the field were firsters and no one has run back yet so it's hard to get a gauge on if the race will be strong. Sire gets 17% with route runners on dirt. Trainer last 2 starters won (at 36-1) and 2<sup>nd</sup> a head..

<b>PICK: 8 SHE'S SO COAL</b> Flashed a bit of speed in the debut at CD before fading as a 43-1 chance. That was a deep MSW and the time was fast for that day. Consider an allowance went 6F in 1:11.1 early in the card. 8 <sup>th</sup> beaten 12.5 lengths returned to run 2 <sup>nd</sup> in a MSW on turf at CD. 1 <sup>st</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> also ran 2 <sup>nd</sup> next in an opt clm at TP and MSW at GP. Trainer 23% w/ 2 <sup>nd</sup> time starters at OP.		<b>PICK: 11 LITTLE KRUSH</b> Hawthorne shipper ran third at 5-1 in the debut in a MSW there. The final time was very fast (:56.4). The winner ran second next time out in the 150k Advent here at OP (got a Beyer of 84). This trainer had one runner who ran in a 50k maiden claiming race here at OP that was on the board in the debut. The one (2023) won for the 50k tag at 9-2 odds.		<b>PICK: 9 BLACK MAGIC RIVER</b> Chris Hartman is 3 for 7 (43%) with another who was third (ridden by Tyler Bacon) with a debut MSW runner here at OP and off at 8-1 or less. The dam was 2 <sup>nd</sup> in her debut (at GP) and a sib won by over 6 first out in MSW (at RP) in Oct of this year (she's a 3YO). Dam is a sib to Mo Don't Know (a 1.3M Ohio-bred earner who won 27 times). Sharp worktab.	
<b>VALUE: 4 MISS CHOCOLATTE</b> Dangerous trainer with Ark-bred maidens. This one was a 12-1 chance in the common race run here on 12/12. Rank in the early stages and that cost her a better finish late in the race. Blinkers are added and she stretches out in this spot. Witt is 2 for 18 (11%) with 7 in the money (39%) with a sprint to route runner at OP. She should run better here.		<b>VALUE: 2 HIGHLY CONNECTED</b> Hasn't done much in two starts but there are reasons for a form reversal today. First off, he was in 2 very tough MSW races. The winner of the last start (won by 20 lengths) won the Grade 2 Ky Jockey Club next. 8 <sup>th</sup> beaten 39 returned to win a MSW by 6 at WO. Blinkers are removed and he comes in as a first time gelding. Cuts back in distance for this one.		<b>VALUE: 7 FRENCH FRICTION</b> This is a well-bred daughter of City of Light. The sire won \$5.6M and last two wins were in the G1 BC Dirt Mile and G1 Pegasus. Female line produced 1995 G1 BC Juvenile Fillies winner My Flag and the champion, undefeated G1 BC Distaff winner Personal Ensign. Comes in with a perfectly spaced worktab for Mark Casse. Note a bullet move here on 12/12.

<b>PICK: 5 PAVING</b> The second dam was the sensational race mare, Brownie Points, for Donnie Von Hemel. She won just short of \$1M in her career on both dirt and turf. She was third in the '06 G2 Fantasy on this track. Thomas Amoss filly 8-1 winner in the debut at ELP. That was a key race. The show finisher has since won 3x including a stakes at GP. Can be any kind/		<b>PICK: 1 BUCKEYE FAVORITE</b> If we only saw her first 2 starts on the past performances, she'd be favored in here. She was third at nearly 50-1 from the widest 11 post in the debut. She was a close 4 <sup>th</sup> from the widest 12 post at SAR in open MSW in the second start. Can excuse the turf last out. Might have been too close to a fast pace two back (early pace setters were up the track).		<b>PICK: 10 KID CHARLEMAGNE</b> Was bet in the debut at CNL and ran evenly. They moved to the turf and split the 6-horse stakes field in the second start. Rank two back and faded. Blinkers came back off in the last start and he crushed an overmatched md claimer at Del Mar. Perfectly placed for this as it is restricted to 50k claiming starters. Worked well on this track since last start.	
<b>VALUE: 9 AUTHENTIC CAT</b> Female family of the \$1M earner, 2008 G1 Hollywood Gold Cup winner, Mast Track. Ken McPeek is 1 for 2 in a stakes at OP with a 2nd timer. The winner was Dash Attack (won the 2022 Smarty Jones). McPeek is a master with modestly priced purchases that turn into legit graded stakes types. His champion 3YO filly Thorpedo Anna sold for 40k in 2022.		<b>VALUE: 9 YES JULIA</b> She has a full sibling who liked the turf but the pedigree is better for the dirt. She was off slow from a wide post going 5F on the grass at CD in the debut. Despite that, she made up some ground and passed some late to get within 5 in the end. Pretty sharp 4F gate move on 12/13 on the OP dirt track. She is well-spotted here. Should like the new surface.		<b>VALUE: 11 AFTER PARTY</b> First two starts came on turf and synthetic. He was moved to the dirt track two back and won for fun at GP at nearly 5-1 odds. Moved to high percentage David Jacobson prior to the last start. He got this one to hang in well for 2 <sup>nd</sup> in a starter allowance at Keeneland. He beat 3 foes in that race that are here. This 4k purchase in August is in for 50k here.
