PICK: 2 CUT DOWN THE NETS This one was 4 th out of 9 runners in the debut. While well-beaten in there, it might turn out to be a decent run. The winner won back in the G3 Sanford by 6 with an 85 Beyer. 6 th , 8 th , 9 th (beaten 18, 23 and 29 lengths) all hit the board next time out in MSW. This trainer is 3 for last 6 with 2nd timers. Rider move to Velazquez.	PICK: 3 MIDNIGHT CONCERTO 5YO mare has given a good account of herself in most of her starts. She was just second beaten less than a length at 7-1 in a 200k stakes here. Last time on Lasix was two back when she won easily at around 6-1 odds at Aqueduct. Late runner has been involved earlier in the last two starts. Good post and good trip likely here.	PICK: 4 BELLACOSE She made her debut for this trainer nearly two years ago to the day here. She won that race by over 10 in a MSW. She was on a wet turf course and muddy track in 2 of the next 4 starts. In the two fast track races in between, she won once (two back) and faded in a 100k stakes. First start off a long layoff. Check the betting.
VALUE: 8 PAREA Pretty well bred first time starter. New sire won the G1 Carter for trainer Mott. He has a couple of debut winners in his first crop and that includes Harper's Corner who won twice by daylight. She took a 200k stakes here by over 5 (88 Beyer). Since 2024, Maker is 4 for 12 in NY-bred MSW with a 1ster sprinting on dirt.	VALUE: 6 PRETTY TAPIT Dangerous connections here. Joe Sharp took over the training for this one before the start two back. He got a win and runner-up finish in the two starts with him and both came with Saez aboard. The win last out at CD was at this distance. She was forwardly placed in there and that might have her on the lead in this one.	VALUE: 9 CARARRA She was claimed from Brad Cox for 30k just 3 back at Aqueduct. It's not easy to claim off of Cox. This one is 1 for 1 at Saratoga. She broke her maiden here in the mud back in 2024. Decent 4 th two back when she was about 2 behind the runner-up as the winner got loose in there. Blinkers off and Rosario up. She will fit here.

PICK: 10 ANTONELLI

Trainer Clement won 3 straight with 2YO first timers routing on the turf in MSW here at SAR. All 3 of them were in August last year and one ridden by Franco. They were all between 2-1 and 5-2 odds. 2nd dam won 840k as a dirt sprinter. Sire won nearly \$2M in 13 starts as a turf sprinter for Wesley Ward. Check tote.

VALUE: 11 AND THE RUNNER IS

Connections have to be eyeing this debut spot at 1M on the turf. The pedigree is turf on turf for this grassy distance. Dam won 400k on the grass routing. Sib is G1 Blue Grass winner and star turf distance gelding Burnham Square. 400k purchase last September at Keeneland gets the services of Irad Ortiz for this spot.

She really did very little in either of her starts so far this past spring. She beat one home in the debut as a 12-1 chance at GP. That was a very strong field. That winner has since won a G3. Despite the poor last race she gets Prat to ride. Prat has won 5 of 8 starts (neck from 6 for last 8) when up for Gargan. We'll see more.

VALUE: 12 AMENDED DREAMER

She spent the first 8 starts of her career in the ranks of MSW company. She finally dropped in for a tag last time out and she was a solid third. That was also her first start with blinkers on. She had a couple of starts where she had poor dispatches from the gate. A slow breeze before a race a tip-off for Antonucci. Good price.

Winner of her last start had won the G1 Frizette back in 2024 by 9-lengths and won the 2025 G1 CCA Oaks by 15-lengths. She was making a comeback and was sent off at 3-5 and won wire to wire. This filly was 6 lengths in front of the rest of the field as second place finisher. 4 for 4 in the money here. She'll be finishing.

VALUE: 4 STRONG STATE

Looked like a different runner off the layoff last year. She won two straight including an allowance on this track before a runner-up finish in the G3 Dogwood at 29-1. 7-wide trip two back at CD and laid off until her last start. Clearly needed that race. Just started to run late there. Winner won a PRM stakes (90 Beyer) Friday.

PICK: 3 SARATOGA TEA

Trainer Rodolphe Brisset has had 5 debut 2YO's in a restricted MSW dirt sprint. He won once (here at SAR in 2022) and was in the top 3 in 4 of the 5 starts with those runners. This is a 250k purchase who is bred to sprint on both sides of the pedigree. Sire gets 20% with debut 2YO's. These are typical works for Brisset.

VALUE: 2 HONEST OWEN

This trainer Kelly Breen gets a respectable 17% (15 for 90) with debut runners sprinting on the dirt. Sire was a sprinter. He was out of the G1 winning sprinter Honest Lady. Female line is sprint influenced as well. Dam is by the G1 sprint winner Smoke Glacken. The works are decent. Could've faced easier at Monmouth.

He got away slowly in the last start and was dead last halfway through the race. He came running strongly to get within two lengths in the end despite a 7-wide trip on the turn. That was the first start after a claim for Joe Sharp. He is 21% second off the claim. Female family were all routers. Franco rode him in last 2 wins.

VALUE: 2 RABAJA

It's true his form looks terrible and this trainer has a single win on the season. But there are some excuses for the poor form. Bad starts in the last two. Set a fast pace three back when forced into a 46.2 half and he rightly tired in there. It's possible he is just going the wrong way but look for Zayas to put him on the lead.

PICK: 2 MYKONOS

Drew wide posts in 3 straight. He got to the rail from the widest 9 post two back and almost won the race getting beaten by just a head setting the pace. Was tracking behind the speed while wide last out and he didn't have any late kick. Broke first in the last 2. Prat will get him on the lead here. Placed at the right level.

VALUE: 7 OUT OF THE FOG

He's had some chances to break through and has not done it yet. Last was going very long so that one can be overlooked. Adds blinkers for the first time. Was pretty decent at this level in two races on this track in 2025 sprinting on the turf. Fired at long odds in a tough mdn clm at TP four back. Would use in exotics.
