**ON THIS DATE (1990)** – **SUPER ABOUND** is the only Minnesota-bred to ever win a Grade 1 race. It came on September 3, 1990 when he upset his more famous stablemate, and Kentucky Derby winner, Unbridled, in the Secretariat Stakes on the turf at Arlington Park. The Frances Genter owned entry finished first and second for trainer Carl Nafzger.
